

Supply List for Quilt Carrier

This carrier is terrific for carrying your large, rolled quilts to show and tell at guild meetings. For the outside of the quilt carrier choose a busy print that you love. The inside should be a plain fabric that will show all your stitching. This is a good project to practice new quilting designs. When loading the fabric on your frame, treat the outside fabric like the backing and the inside fabric like the quilt top. Choose a thread color that matches the outside fabric, but contrasts with the inside fabric.

Material List

- 1 yard top fabric, 42"-44" wide
- 1 yard backing fabric, 42"-44" wide
- 1 yard batting, 38" x 46"
- (2) 24" wood dowels 3/8" or 1/2" diameter
- 4 yards cording for ties
- 2 yards webbing for handles, 1" or 1 1/2" wide
- 3/4 yard accent fabric for dowel pockets, cord tube and binding.
- Fusible interfacing 2 strips 2 1/2" x 26"

From the accent fabric, cut:

- 2 strips, 2 1/2" x 26" (dowel pockets) fuse interfacing to wrong side of these strips.
- 2 strips, 2" x 37" (cord tubes)
- 4 strips, 2 1/2" x width of fabric for binding
