Card Trick Ornaments





I made these card trick ornaments to give to our grandson. I had given him the quilt for HS graduation.

These were about 3 inches square when finished. Could be $\frac{1}{2}$ inch larger. I used 1-1/16 inch squares for the cards. Could just use 1 inch.

- 1. Cut a square of fabric for the background.
- 2. Iron fusible web on the card fabrics before cutting the cards. Arrange them on the background fabric (overlap them). Iron them in place.
- 3. Cut a piece of scrap fabric and a piece of batting the size of the square. Layer them together and free-motion quilt them.
- **4.** Cut fabric for the back the size of the square. Cut a 6 inch ribbon for each.
- 5. Pin ribbon in place. Pin right sides of the quilted top and back together.
- **6.** Sew with 1/4 inch seam, slightly rounding corners all four corners (they'll look better) and leaving an opening at the bottom to turn right side out.
- 7. Turn right side out. Stuff with loose fiberfill. Hand stitch the opening closed.
