TEMPLATE FREE TUMBLER BLOCK PATTERN

I used five inch charm squares throughout. I made a finished block but if you are making a larger piece you will want to make long rows. Squares need to be lined up all in the same direction, face up or face down. I used face down so I could draw my cutting line and see it clearly. I cut four squares at a time with a rotary cutter.

Measure in at the top, one inch. Draw a cutting line from that one inch mark to the bottom corner.

The top will measure 3", the bottom 5"

for the side pieces I then cut one block again in the middle. One block will make the end pieces for one row. Again layer squares in the same direction. Also you could cut the side pieces from a 2.5" strip. Pieces measure, 1.5 along the top, 2.5 along the bottom and
