
Using the photographic "Rule of thirds" Divide design like this. Point of interest is where 2 lines any of the 2 lines cross. Looks like your cottage lands on one of those crosses—great.



Another maxim is not to cut the picture in half with a horizon line.—that's the red line. This might be part of the problem Yes the sky is the horizon line, but sky color blends in with the mountains and this lack of great contrast gives the illusion of the green grass as the horizon line.



So now what do you do? Crop the picture!
