

Q as Y G Log Cabin CLASS #1 (2 COLORS) 72 X 72

Log Cabin Quilt as You Go in two colors plus Hearth.

All cutting must be done before class.

Cutting directions: TOP 16 blocks See the General Sewing directions

Darkest color (A) 15 strips 2 1/2" x wof blocks (38" fabric)

4 1/2 yards 14 strips 2 3/4" x wof blocks (35" fabric)

7 strips 2 3/8" x wof top sashing (18" fabric) dark on dark

4 strips 6" wide x apx. 72" long for borders (measure top)

1 strip 6" wide to recut 4) 6" squares for corners

Center flame (B) 1 strip 2 1/2" x wof, cut into 16) 2 1/2" squares

Lightest color (C) 10 strips 2 1/2" x wof blocks

2 1/2 yards 12 strips 2 3/4" x wof blocks

11 strips 2 3/8" top sashing, light on light etc. See Pic.

We will cut length as we go.

(When all blocks are made we will true up to 14" sq.)

Backing: Cut 16) 15" squares to back the block

4 1/2 yards (Cut off 1 yard and set aside. If you cut a 30" strip from one

side of your fabric that is left, then cut out the 15" squares from that, you will have apx. 12" wide piece left to cut sashing. (All are 1 1/2" wide)

Cut the long pieces of sashing needed from this piece, then cut the shorter pieces from the balance with the yard you put aside.

Cut back sashing 5) 1 1/2" w by width of Quilt between rows and L/R border

4) 1 1/2" w by 6" for corners, connected to T/B borders

2) 1 1/2" w x width of Quilt with side borders attached.

12) 1 1/2" wide x 14" between blocks

Back Borders: 4) strips 6" wide x apx. 72" long

2 yards 1) strip 6" wide to recut into 4) 6" squares.

QUILT BATT:

Batting: Cut 16) 15" squares to batt the block

4) 6 x 72 for borders

4) 6" sq. for corners

Use scrap batt when you can.

Need thread in bobbin to match back sashing.

Need thread on top to match top sashing.
