

## Supplies:

Paper Doll Panel  
1 yd light background fabric  
1/2 yd each of four different  
coordinating fabrics  
1 yd fusible fleece  
1/2 yd of  
Steam A  
Seam  
1 yd  
Ribbon

## Construction:

Cut 8 -12" sqs out of background fabric  
Cut 8 – 10 1/2' sqs from coordinating fabrics (2 of each)  
Cut 8 - 8 x10 1/2 sqs from coordinating fabrics (2 of each for  
pockets). Fold lengthwise & press. Sew on bottom of 10 1/2 sq.  
matching raw edges.

Cut 2 1/2 stripes out of remainder of coordinating fabrics. Sew strips  
together, enough to cut out 2 – 10 1/2"sqs.

Fuse Steam A Seam to back of Dolls

Fuse Fusible Fleece to back of Doll Clothes

Cut out Dolls & Doll Clothes. Place in a ziploc bag, keeping  
clothes with the doll they were intended for.

Fuse Fusible Fleece to back of 12" sqs.

If you are intending to embroider or use any decorative stitch  
on your book, do so now. Position & fuse doll to 12" sq. Cut  
this square down to 10 1/2".

## Assembling Book:

Starting with book cover, sew RST with 1 st doll page. Leave an  
opening to turn. Turn, press & edge stitch. Opposite of that page  
should be a coordinating 10 1/2 sq with pocket attached. This page  
should be sewn RST, with 2<sup>nd</sup> doll page. Turn, press & edge stitch.  
Continue until book is complete ending with back book cover.

## Eyelets:

Make eyelets with the Bernina eyelet maker. Placing 2 eyelets 2"  
down from top & bottom of edge of book. Cut your ribbon in half &  
thread through the eyelets & tie a bow.
