

### 12" Lattice Block Variation

Work with strips that are cut lengthwise (not across the width of your fabric.)

Cut your strips 1-5/8th inches wide.

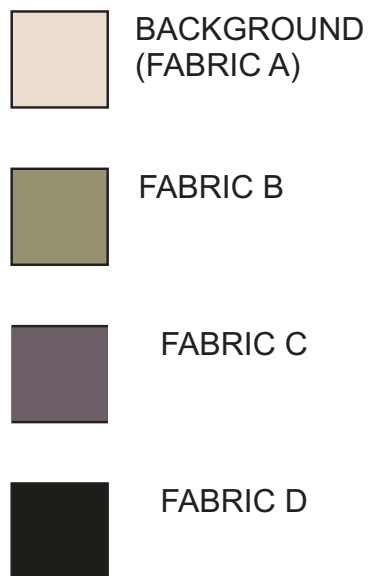
All squares should be cut 1-5/8" x 1-5/8".

If you pre-cut your other pieces, cut them slightly longer than shown, then trim to proper size after pressing.

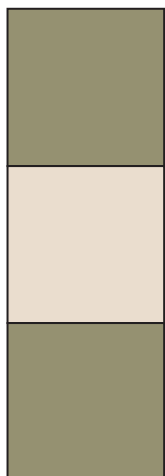
Press to the dark.

The piecing diagram and patch sizes assume you are using a precise 1/4" seam.

The block might finish to a bit more than 12-1/2" square. Trim back as necessary to achieve a 12-1/2" square (unfinished.)



## STEPS 1 & 2

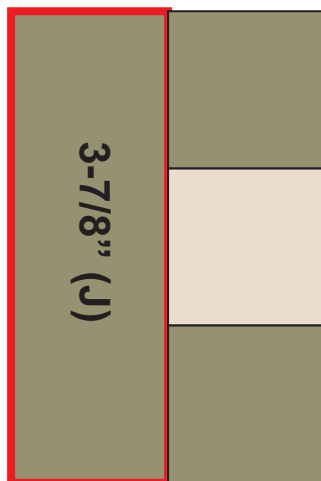


1. Cut one square from a background strip, and two squares from Fabric B. Sew together as illustrated.

The center should now measure 1-1/8" between the seams.

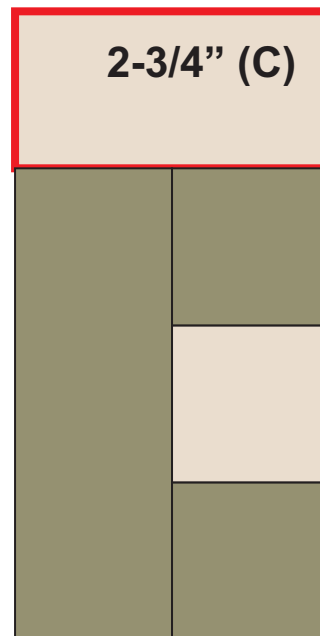
## STEP 3

Attach a piece of Fabric B as illustrated.

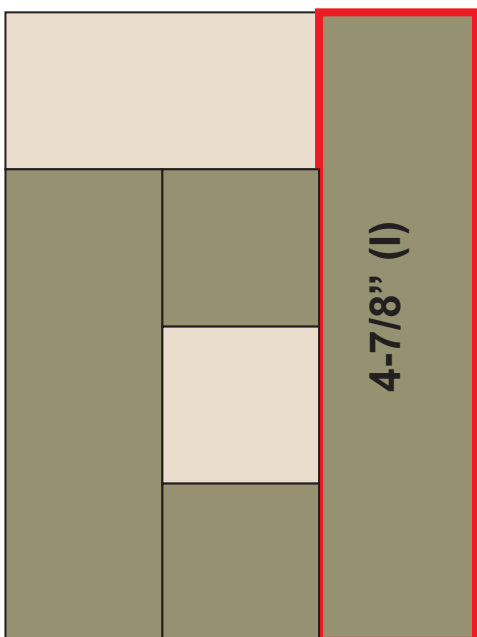

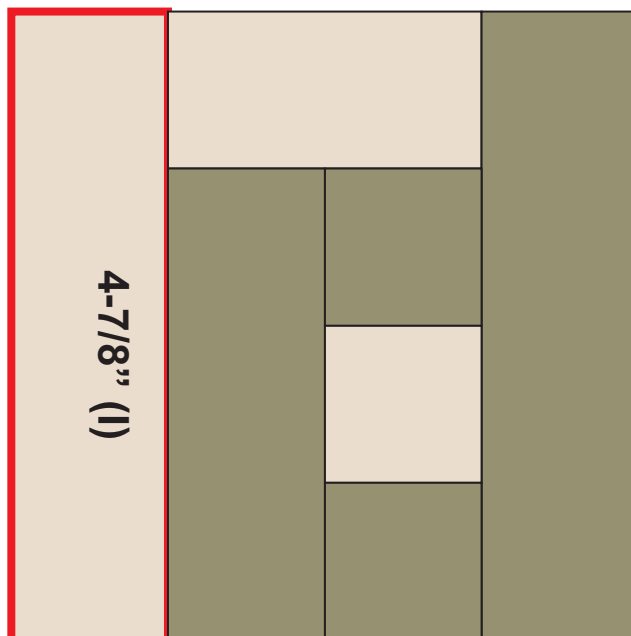
Continue adding pieces as shown in each illustration



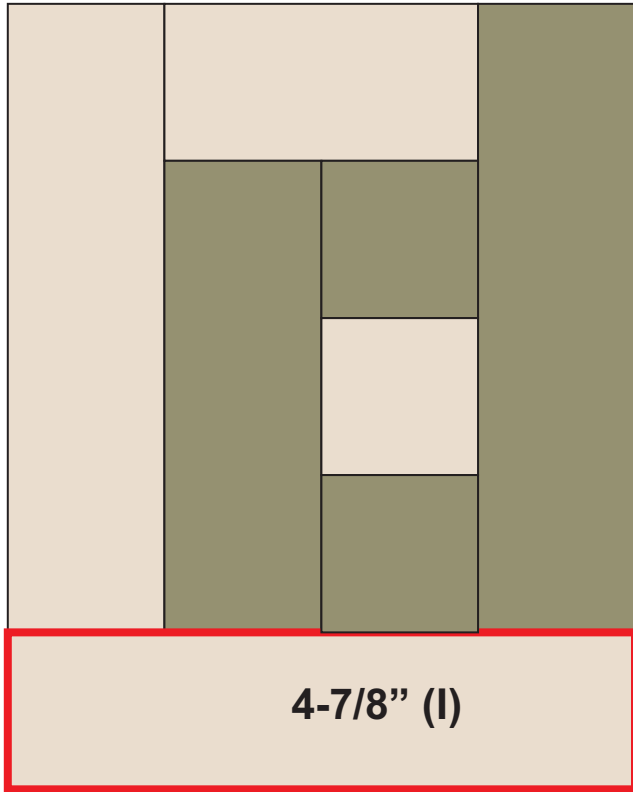

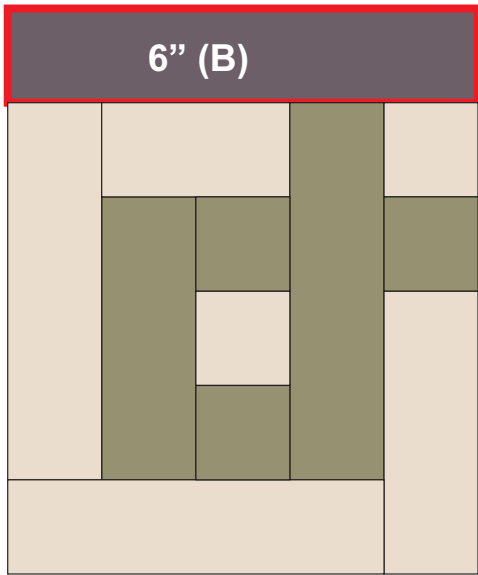
Using two squares and one rectangle, make the set shown at left.



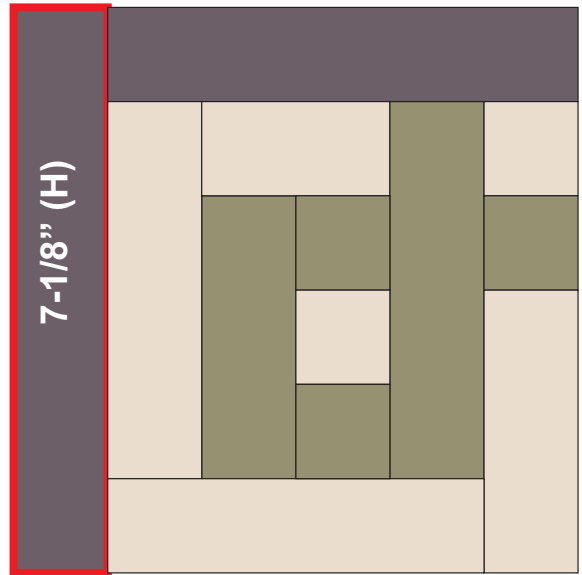
## STEP 9

Sew the 3-piece set to the side of the block, as illustrated.

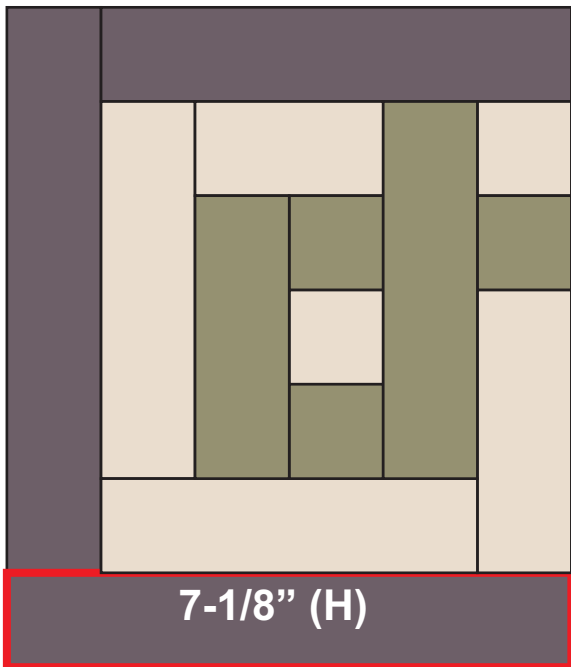
