


HEXAGON

Kaye Wood's *Hexagon Star* project is perfect for beginners since there are no points to match. The center of the star is a perfect place to feature a large fabric motif such as the flower on the star shown below. MATERIALS

NOTE: Fabrics in the quilt shown are from the Paris Flea Market collection by Three Sisters for Moda.

- 1 fat eighth* red large-scale floral print for center hexagon
- 1 fat quarter** cream print for triangles
- $\frac{3}{4}$ yard red print for inner and outer borders and backing
- 1 fat eighth* light green print for middle border

View & Do™ Hexagons or template material

*fat eighth = 9" x 20"

**fat quarter = 18" x 20"

Size: 15" x 17"

If you are not using Kaye's View & Do™ Hexagons, make a template from the hexagon pattern on page 72. Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances.
