




AMERICA THE BEAUTIFUL BLOCK

Approx. Finished Size 9" square

One sampler will yield approx. 10 blocks, 5 of each block style.

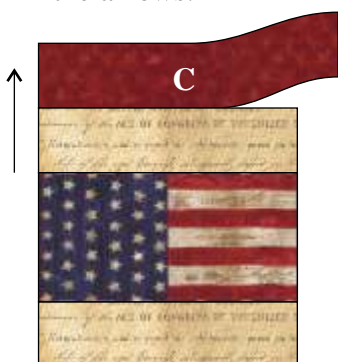
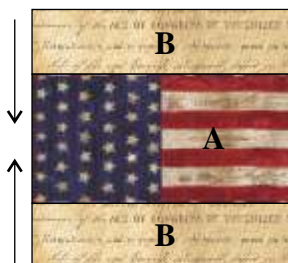
Cutting for two blocks.

	108161 Patriotic Literature, Blue E Two 2" x 8" (directional)	FQ
	108162 Flag Patch, Antique A One 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" (*cut lengthwise)	FQ
	108163 Stargazers, Navy D Two 2" x 8"	FQ
	108164 Stargazers, Brick C Four 2" x 8"	FQ
	108160 Patriotic Literature, Natural B Four 2" x 6-1/2" (directional)	FQ
	108159 Waving Flags & Stars, Antique A One 3-1/2" x 6-1/2"	FQ

*Lengthwise grain = parallel to the selvage. This should yield approx. 6 flags. Flags cut crosswise grain will be 1/4" too short!

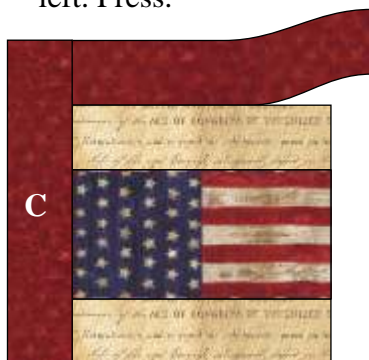
DIRECTIONS

1- Sew a B strip to the top and bottom of the A strip. Press the seam allowances in the direction indicated by the arrows.



3- Sew a red C to the left side of the block. Press.

2- Sew a red C to the top edge of the block. Stop the seam approx. 2" away from the end. See diagram to the left. Press.



4- Sew a navy blue D to the bottom of the block. Press.



5- Sew a blue E to the right edge of the block. Press.



6- Finish sewing the red C strip from step 1 to the block. Press.

7- Repeat this process for a second block using the Waving Flags print in position A.



NOTE: Please read the entire pattern carefully. Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this pattern. Use a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise stated.

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
