Grandmother's Flower Garden —Hexagon Cutting Technique

Hexagons—easy to cut with the Starmaker® 6.

A great class idea—teach this technique!

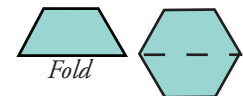
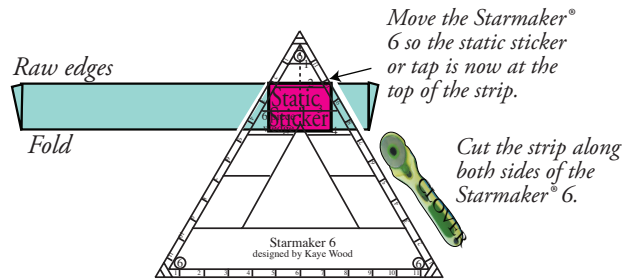
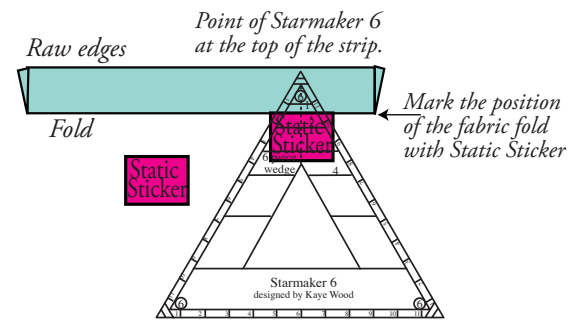
Give a quick demo or have a hands-on sit-and-sew class.

Make any size hexagons

1. Cut a strip of fabric the height of the desired hexagon size.
2. Fold the strip in half lengthwise.
3. Place the point of the Starmaker® 6 at the top of the strip. Mark the position of the fabric fold on the Starmaker® 6 with tape or a piece of static sticker™.
4. Move the Starmaker® 6 up so the fold marker is now at the top of the strip. Cut on both sides of the Starmaker® 6 for a perfect hexagon.

Easy Hexagon Designs by Kaye Wood has more detailed cutting and sewing for hexagons.

Lots of projects for hexagons, divided hexagons, hexagon log cabins and honeycombs and fussy-cut hexagons, including quilts, wallhangings, and Christmas Tree Skirts are all included. Easy mitered binding technique for hexagon shapes.



Check out Kaye's book, *Easy Hexagon Designs*, for her sewing directions for perfect hexagons. Slow-downs, like ripping, are eliminated and inside points will be perfect.
