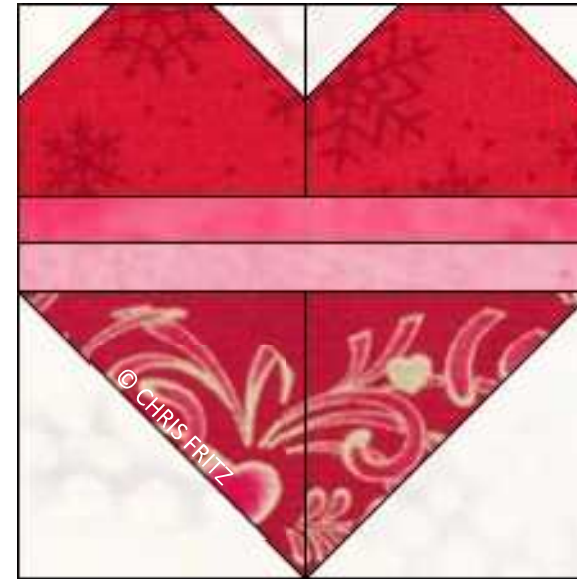
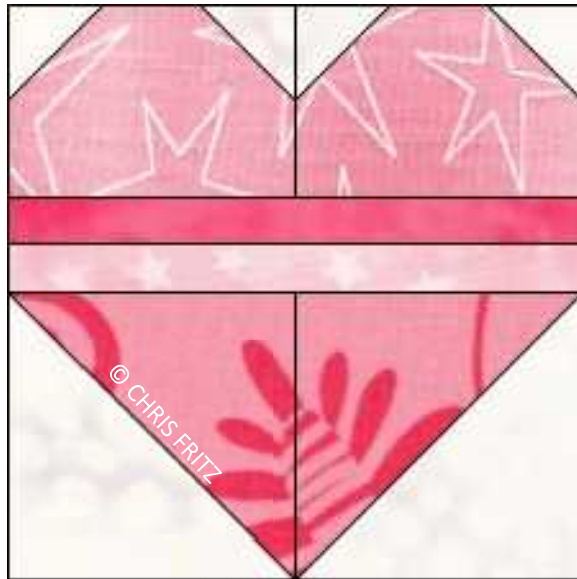


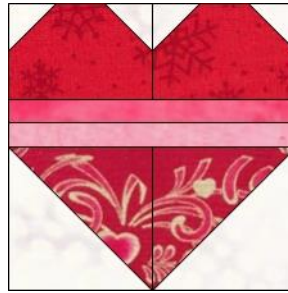
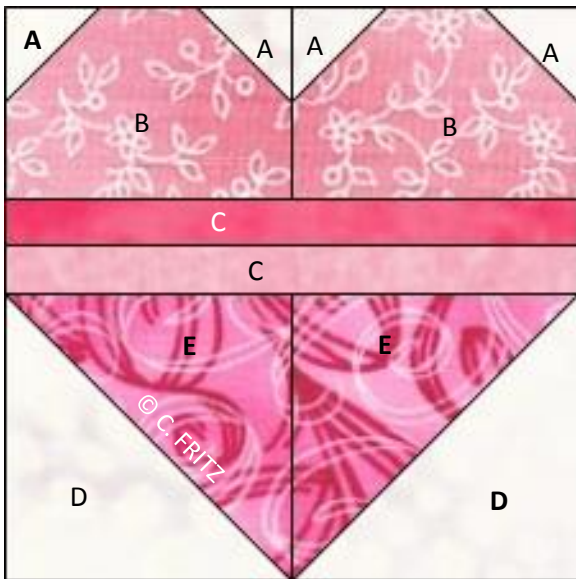
## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: FRIENDSHIP HEART BLOCK

| C     | Horizontal stripe              | 12.5" x 1.5"    | 1              | 12.5" x 1.5"    | Solid or hand dye:dark pink  |
| C     | Horizontal stripe              | 12.5" x 1.5"    | 1              | 12.5" x 1.5"    | Solid or hand dye:light pink |
| D*    | Base of Block: L and R corners | 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" | 1 : ea D/E = 2 | 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" | Background                   |
| E*    | Base of Heart: L and R corners | 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" | 1 : ea D/E = 2 | 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" | Med print: red or pink       |

\*D/E are sewn as a square, RST on both sides of a drawn diagonal line, then cut in half on the diagonal line. This will yield (2) 6.5" squares for D and E

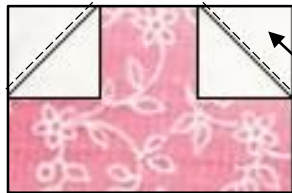


## Friendship Heart: Pattern Instructions

**Cutting instructions are on the 2nd page of this pattern.** After cutting fabric, read the entire pattern before assembly. Seam is a scant 1/4 inch. Please return block to the February meeting as 12.5" block.

Background fabric: For (4) piece [A]'s 3" x 12"; and a 6 7/8" square for (2) piece [D]'s.

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back side of the (4) [A] squares.

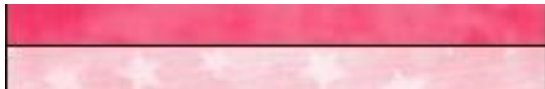


2. Place an [A] square, RST on the corners of the [B] pieces as shown at left. Sew on the drawn lines. Fold back and press the [A] corner so it is RSU. Trim away excess [A] and [B] fabric underneath, leaving a 1/4" seam for all (4) pieces.



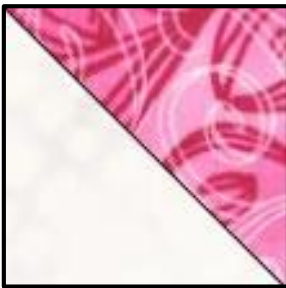
3. Sew (2) [A/B] left and right upper pieces of the upper heart together.

4. Sew (2) [C] pieces together. Following diagram, sew [C/C] strip to upper heart [A/B] piece. Press seams open.



5. To make bottom half of heart:

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back side of one of the squares. Place the (1) [D] and (1) [E] squares, RST. Sew a scant 1/4" seam from the left and right side of the drawn diagonal line.



Press this block. Cut on the diagonal line. This will yield (2), [D/E] HST. Press seams to the dark side. Sew the (2) HST together, referring to the diagram at left.



6, Sew this bottom portion of the block to the other, previously connected sections. The block should finish at 12 1/2"
