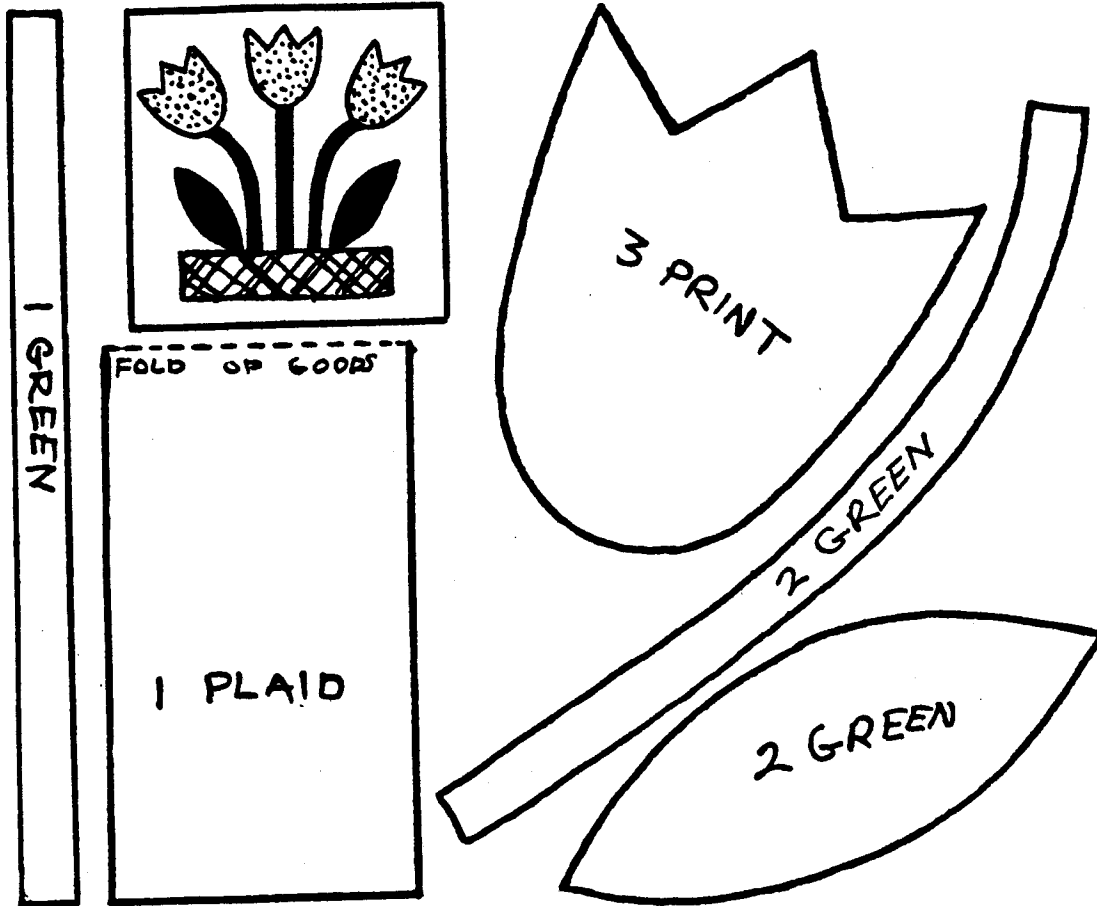


A BOX OF TULIPS.



An ardent quilt piecer, Mrs. Doc Boggs, Brownbranch, Mo., designed this tulip pattern for applique on a square of 1-tone material. A suggestion is that the background square be of a dark green, several shades darker than the green of the leaves, and that the tulip box be of a tan-brown plaid, cut on the bias. The tulips may all be the same hue, or two alike (at each end) or all three in different colors. Mrs. Boggs chose an 11-inch square for her background.
