


## QUILT ASSEMBLY



1. Starting with center rectangle $\mathbf{A}$, sew the $\mathbf{B}$ rectangles to top and bottom. Then add C Blush strips to top and bottom of B. See diagram on left.
2. Next add C Blush strips to sides of center unit. Follow with B strips and D strips to right and left sides of center unit.
3. Add 2 1/2" $\times 16^{\prime \prime}$ D strips to top and bottom of center unit, as shown on diagram on left.
4. Sew (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16$ " E strip to top of center unit. Repeat for bottom. For sides attach (1) F rectangle to each end of an E strip. Make 2. Sew to sides of center unit, as shown on right diagram.
5. Add (1) 1 1/2" $\times 26$ 1/2" D strip to both sides of center unit. Then sew remaining $D$ strips to top and bottom.


Center design is about 6 1/2"

6. To get $\mathbf{G}$ braid center design, cut 1/4" from last line on both sides, as shown on left diagram. Center design measures about $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide. Make 2 strips each $161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ long.
7. Fussy-cut (4) A square tile designs. Attach (2) to ends of one G braid strip. Repeat for remaining $\mathbf{G}$ strip. Then sew A-G units to sides of quilt center. See diagram below.

8. For top and bottom outer borders: fussy-cut $\mathbf{G}$ stripe as shown in right diagram. It should measure about 8 1/2". Cut 2 borders at $35^{\prime \prime}$ long.
9. With stripe design to inside of quilt top, sew $G$ borders to top and bottom of quilt center, as shown in diagram below.
10. Sew (1) H rectangle to ends of an $\mathrm{H}_{5}$ 1/2" $\times 32$ 1/2" strip. Make 2. Sew to sides of quilt center.


FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Assemble the quilt sandwich by placing the backing, batting and top together in layers and baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind in the usual manner.
