t-shirt quilt

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 2 yds Pellon® Nature's Touch® Eco-Cotton blend batting
- 7 yds Pellon® Shir-Tailor® interfacing
- 20 T-Shirts
- 1/4 yd cornerstone fabric
- 1½ yd sashing fabric
- 5 yds backing fabric
- 1/2 yd binding fabric
- Thread
- Omnigrip® 12½" cutting ruler, cutting mat & rotary cutter
- Sewing machine & basic sewing supplies

DIRECTIONS:

WS = Wrong sides:

1. Cut T-shirts at side & shoulder seams. Discard backs. Center 12½" ruler over T-shirt design; cut on all 4 sides. Cut twenty 12½" squares from interfacing.
2. Fuse interfacing to WS of the 12½" T-shirt blocks following manufacturer's instructions.
3. Arrange cut blocks into 5 rows and 4 columns.
4. Cut seventeen 2½"-wide fabric strips from sashing fabric. Subcut strips into forty-nine 2½"x12½" rectangles.
5. Cut two 2½"-wide fabric strips from cornerstone fabric. Subcut strips into thirty 2½" squares.
6. For each row, sew 2½"x12½" sashing rectangles to the sides of the blocks. Start & end with a sashing rectangle. Press seams toward the sashing rectangles.
7. Sew five 2½" cornerstones to four 2½"x12½" rectangles; alternate to create 6 sashing/cornerstone rows. Start & end with a cornerstone. Press seams toward the sashing rectangles.
8. Sew the 6 sashing/cornerstone rows alternately with the block rows. Start & end with a sashing/cornerstone row. Press seams open.
9. Piece quilt back to fit. Layer quilt backing, batting & top. Quilt as desired. Bind quilt.
