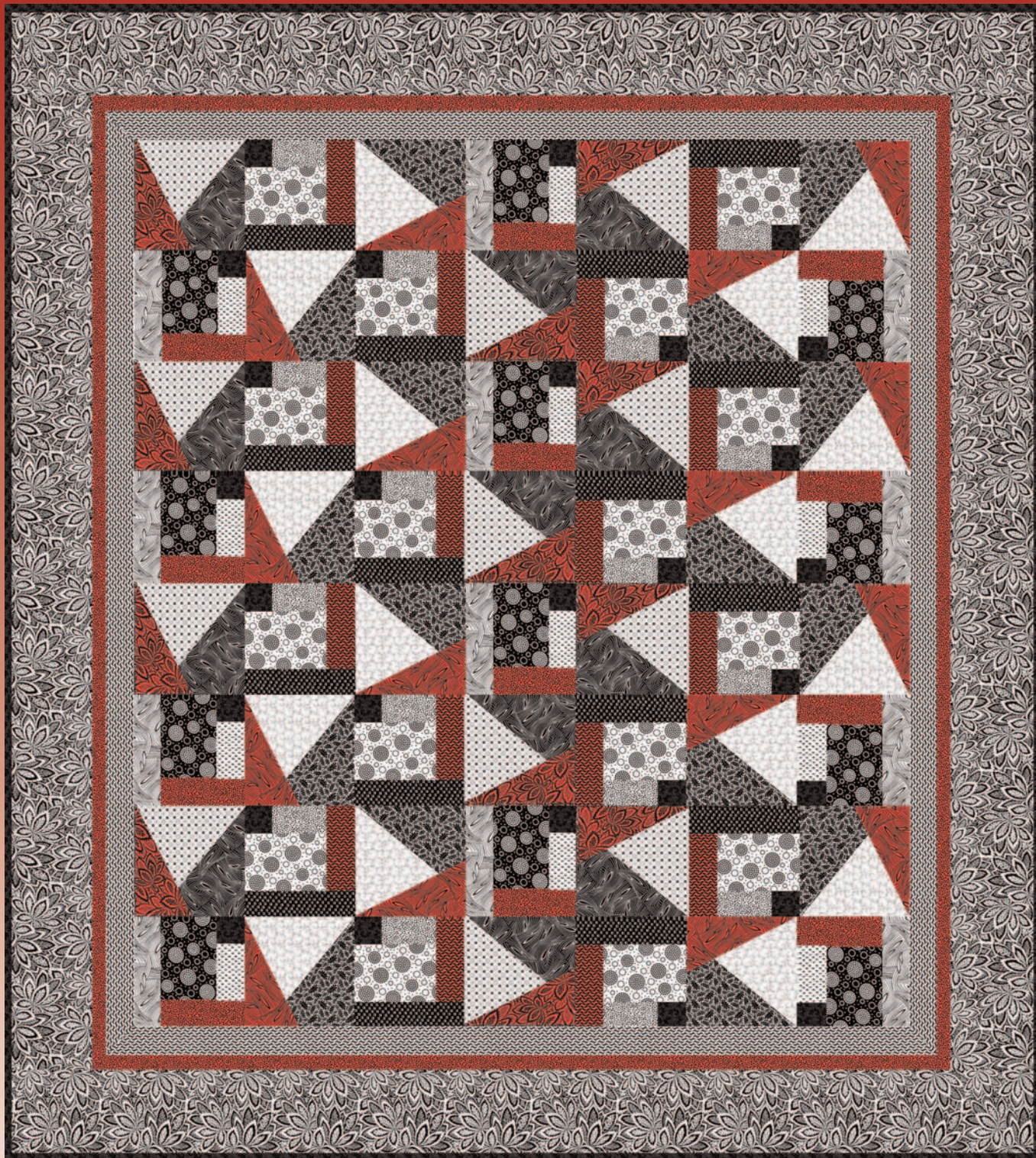


# *Black and White with a Touch of Red*

*All seam allowances are 1/4". Read all directions before beginning. Press all seams as you sew.*

## **Fabric Requirements:**

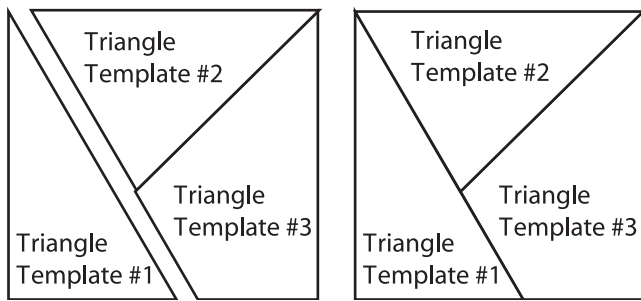
## **Cutting Directions:** (wof indicates cutting on width of fabric)

<b>Fabric A:</b> 1-1/2 yd 5751 Black	Cut (7) 6-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end and recut (2) 6-1/2" x 70-1/2" vertical borders and (2) 6-1/2" x 74-1/2" horizontal borders.
<b>Fabric B:</b> 2/3 yd 5751 Red	Cut (12) triangles using triangle template #1.
<b>Fabric C:</b> 1/2 yd 5752 Black	(2) 6-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (12) 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.
<b>Fabric D:</b> 1/2 yd 5752 White	(2) 6-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (16) 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.
<b>Fabric E:</b> 2/3 yd 5753 Black	Cut (12) triangles using triangle template #3.
<b>Fabric F:</b> 2/3 yd 5753 Red	Cut (16) triangles using triangle template #1.
<b>Fabric G:</b> 2/3 yd 5753 White	Cut (1) 8-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (12) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips.
<b>Fabric H:</b> 2/3 yd 5754 Black	Cut 16 triangles using triangle template #3.
<b>Fabric I:</b> 1 yd 5755 Black	Cut (2) 2-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (28) 2-1/2" squares. Cut (7) 2-1/4" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end for binding.
<b>Fabric J:</b> 2/3 yd 5755 White	Cut 16 triangles using triangle template #2.
<b>Fabric K:</b> 2/3 yd 5756 Red	Cut (1) 6-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (16) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip. Cut (7) 1-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end then cut (2) vertical 1-1/2" x 68-1/2" borders and (2) horizontal 1-1/2" x 62-1/2" borders.
<b>Fabric L:</b> 1/4 yd 5756 White	Cut (1) 4-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (16) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles.
<b>Fabric M:</b> 1/2 yd 5757 White	Cut (12) triangles using triangle template #2.
<b>Fabric N:</b> 1/4 yd 5758 Black	Cut (1) 8-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (16) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips.
<b>Fabric O:</b> 1/4 yd 5758 White	Cut (1) 4-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (12) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips.
<b>Fabric P:</b> 1/4 yd 5759 Red	Cut (1) 6-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (12) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips.
<b>Fabric Q:</b> 2/3 yd 5759 Black	Cut (7) 2-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end and recut (2) vertical 2-1/2" x 70" borders and (2) horizontal 2-1/2" x 66" borders.
<b>Fabric R:</b> 5 yd 5754 White for backing	Cut into (2) equal pieces and sew together selvedge to selvedge for backing

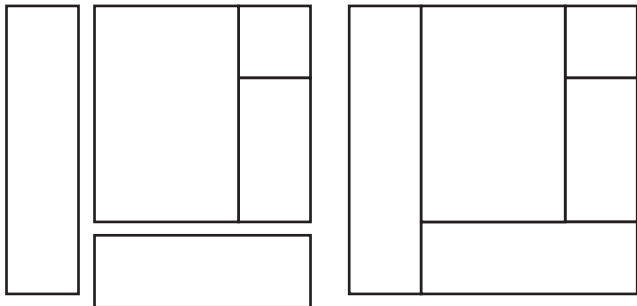
## Sewing Instructions:

1. Referring to the block diagrams, sew a triangle #2 to a triangle #3, then sew triangle #1 to both triangles to complete the triangle block. Make (12) blocks 1 and (16) blocks 2.

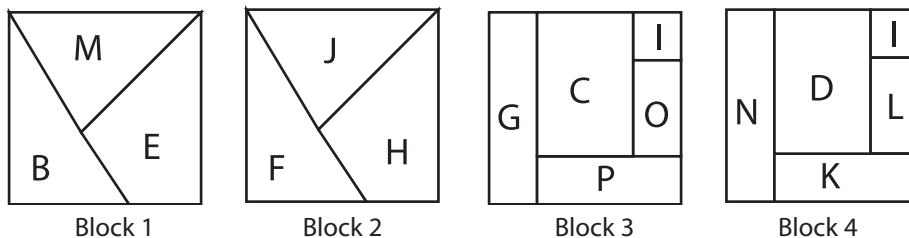


Blocks 1 and 2 Assembly

2. Referring to the block diagrams, sew the rectangles together as shown in the diagram. Make (12) blocks 3 and (16) blocks 4.



Blocks 3 and 4 Assembly

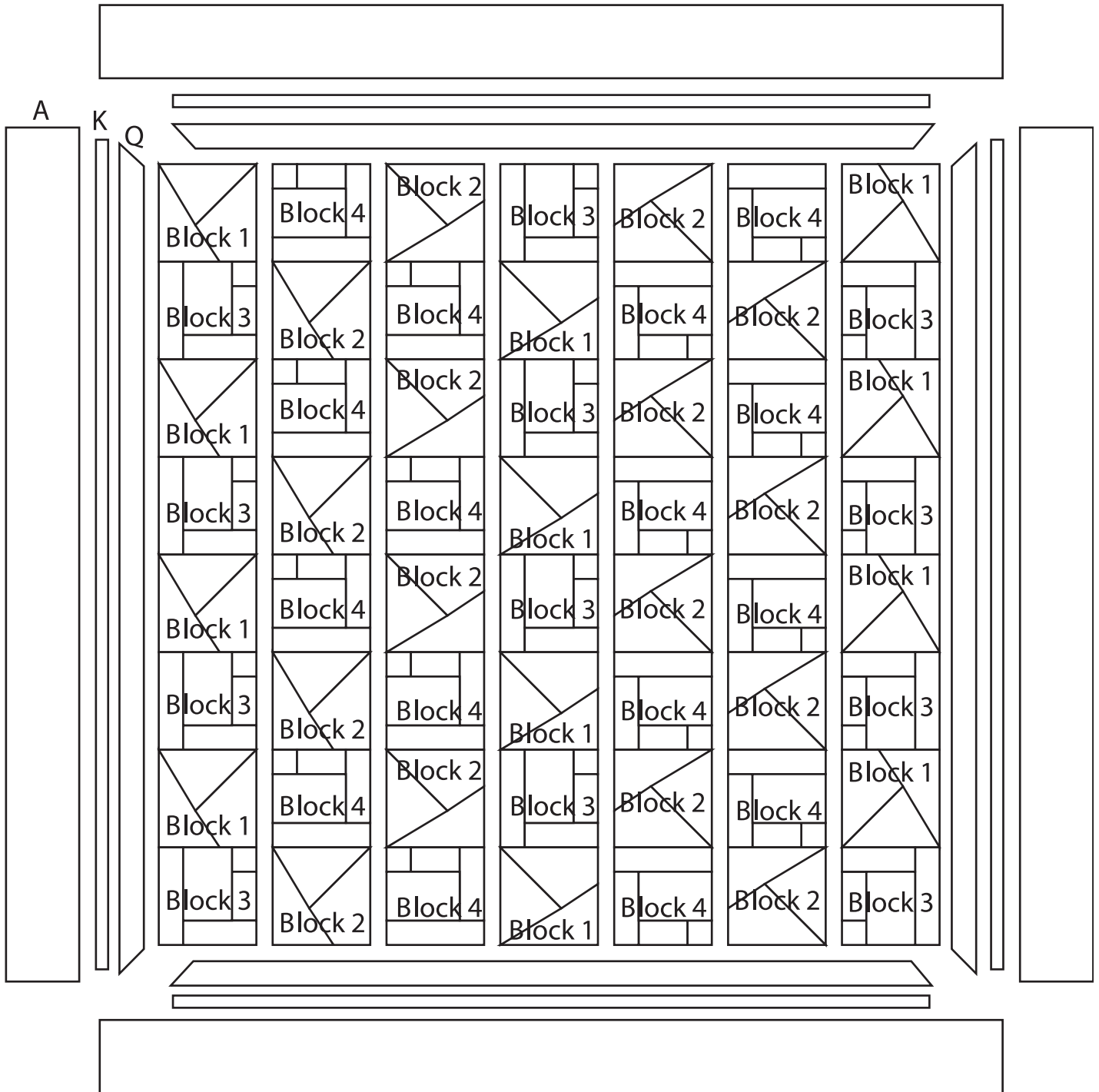


3. The quilt is sewn together in vertical rows. Refer to the quilt assembly diagram to see the block placement and block orientation in each row. Sew (7) vertical rows of (8) blocks each. Sew the rows together.
4. Center and sew the fabric Q vertical borders to opposite sides of the quilt top, stopping 1/4" from the edge at each end of the quilt. Center and sew the fabric Q horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top in the same manner. Miter the corners and trim away excess fabric.
5. Sew the fabric K vertical borders to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew the fabric K horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
6. Sew the fabric A borders to the quilt in the same manner as the borders in step 5.

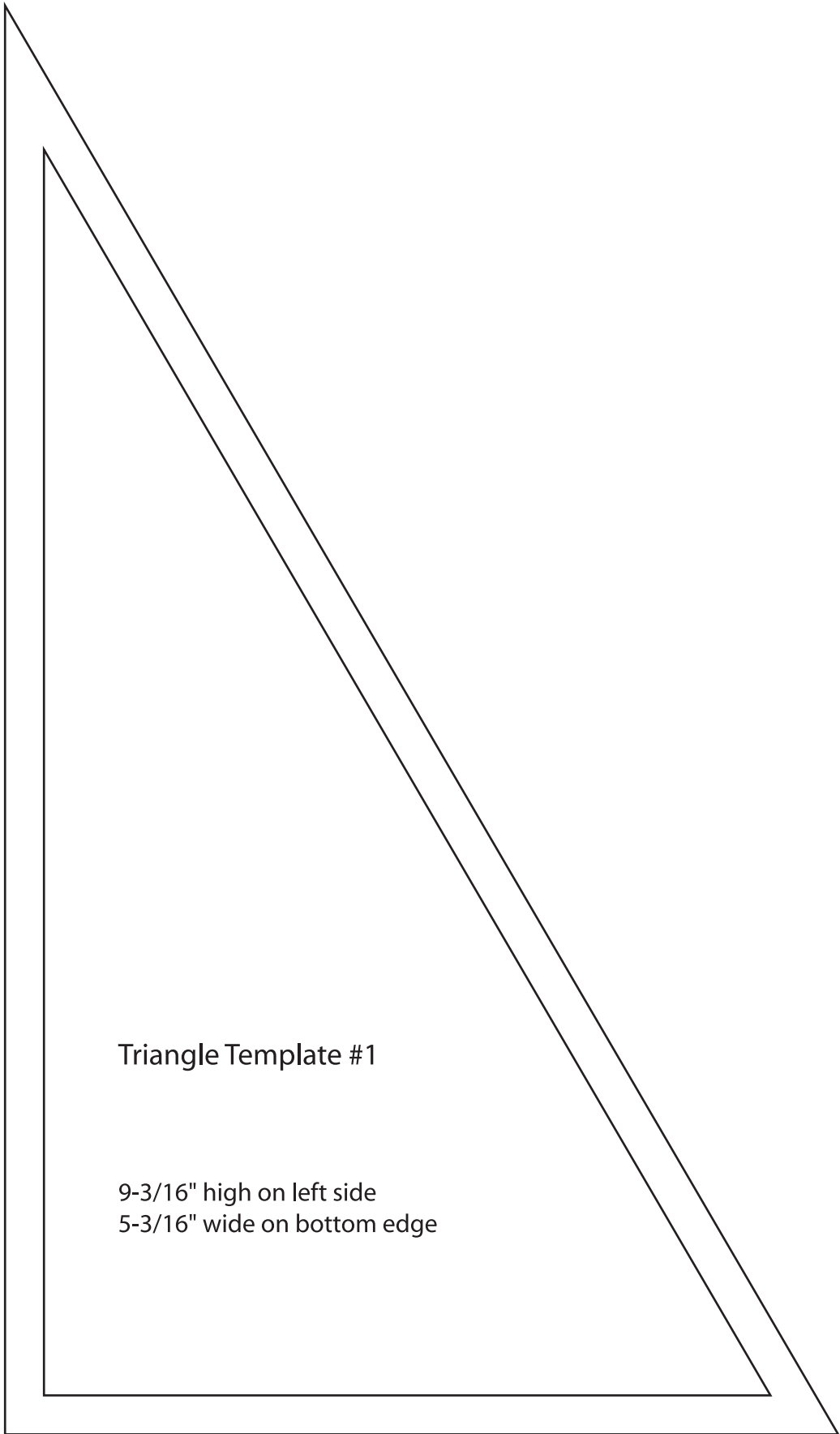
## Finishing:

7. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt the layers together.
8. Fold the fabric I binding together lengthwise and press the fold line. Match raw edges of binding with raw edges of quilt top and sew to quilt top. Turn folded edge to back and sew in place.

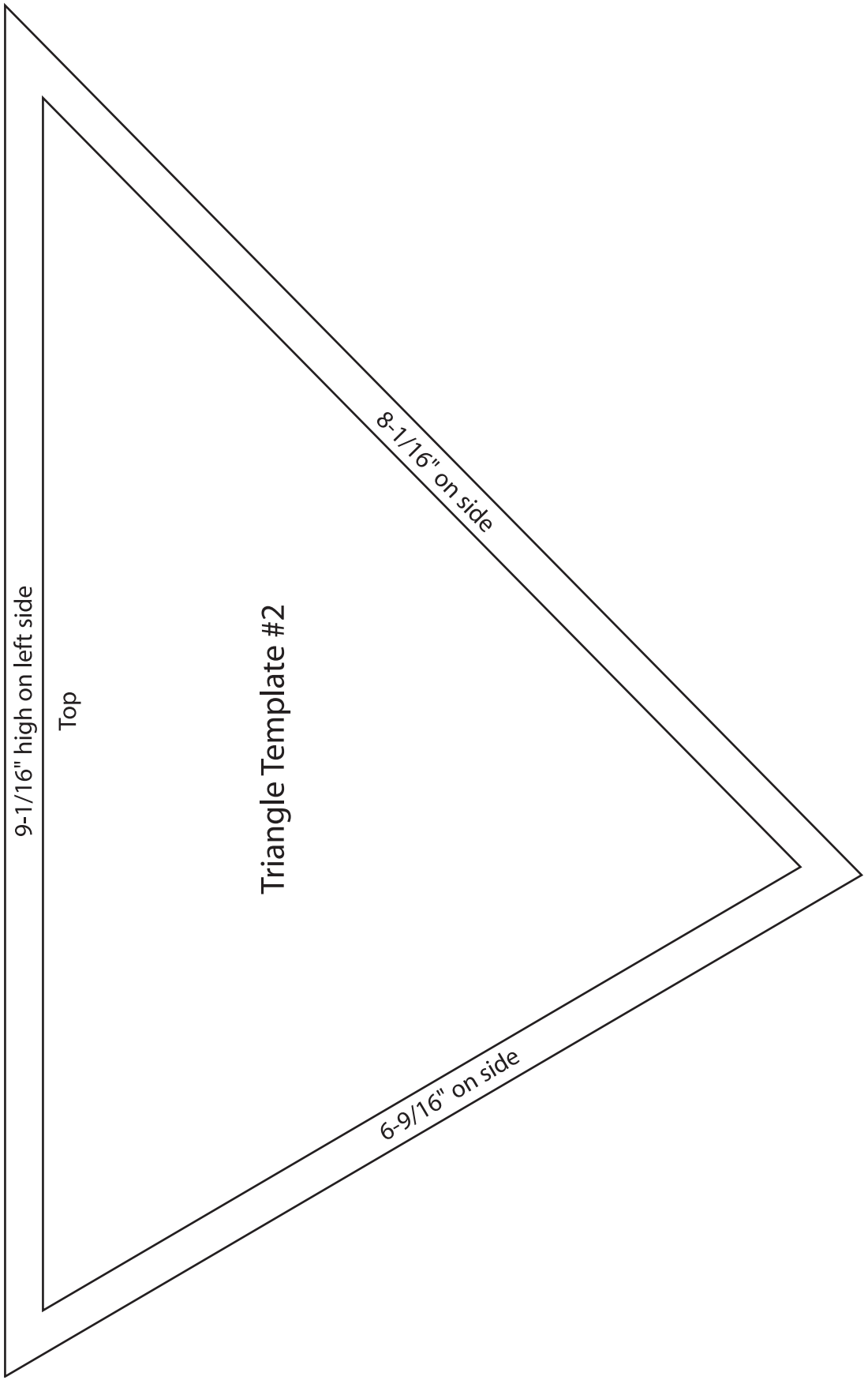
Quilt Assembly Diagram

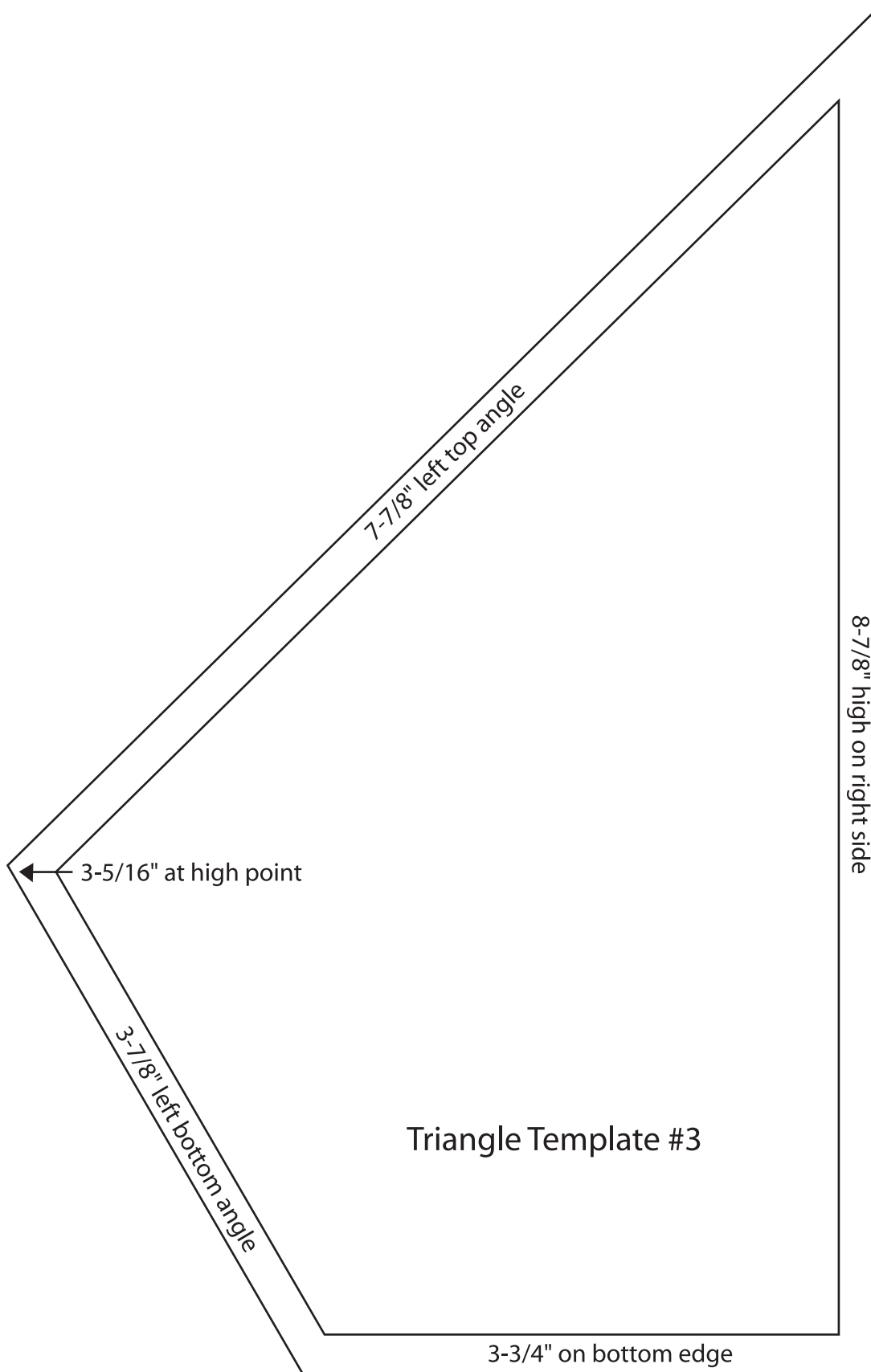


Triangle Template #1
