FINISHED SIZE: 49" SQUARE

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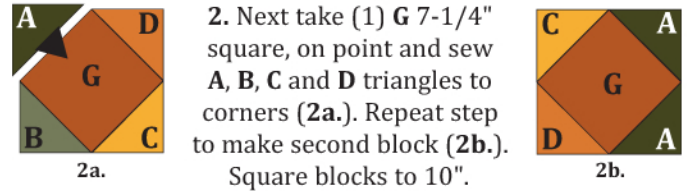
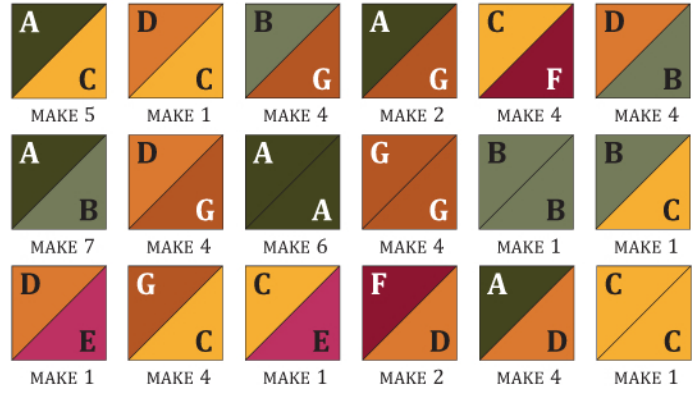

	A Dragonflies 1957-44 Hunter Multi	1/2YD	(17) 5-1/2" squares.
	B Windswept 1959-44 Hunter Multi	1/3YD	(10) 5-1/2" squares.
	C Windswept 1959-33 Orange Mauve	1/3YD	(10) 5-1/2" squares.
	D Dragonflies 1957-33 Orange Mauve	2/3YD	(9) 5-1/2" squares. (4) 2" x WOF strips.
	E Dragonflies 1957-22 Magenta	1/3YD	(1) 5-1/2" squares. (2) 1-1/2" x WOF strips.
	F Windswept 1959-22 Magenta	1/3YD	(3) 5-1/2" squares. (2) 1-1/2" x WOF strips.
	G Floral 1958-33 Pumpkin Multi	1-2/3YD	(11) 5-1/2" squares. (2) 7-1/4" squares. (4) 4-1/2" squares. (4) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. (5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

WOF=WIDTH OF FABRIC

STEP 1: SQUARE AND BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Cut all 5-1/2" squares in half once diagonally. Using the diagrams below, sew the half square triangles together.



2. Next take (1) G 7-1/4" square, on point and sew A, B, C and D triangles to corners (2a.). Repeat step to make second block (2b.). Square blocks to 10".

STEP 2: ROW AND QUILT ASSEMBLY

3. Following the quilt diagram on right, sew squares together to make rows.

Please Note: Watch for proper rotation and placement of certain squares.

Then sew Row 1 to Row 2 and so forth.

STEP 3: ADDING BORDERS

Measure length and width of quilt top before cutting borders, to ensure proper dimensions for borders.

4. Take (2) E 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Add strips to sides of quilt top. Trim to fit.

5. Take (2) F 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Add strips to top and bottom of quilt top. Trim to fit.

6. Take (4) D 2" x WOF strips. Sew (1) strip to each side of quilt top. Trim to fit. Then add remaining D strips to top and bottom of quilt top. Trim to fit.

7. Take (4) G 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew (1) strip to each side of quilt top. Trim to fit. Next measure width of quilt top to determine length of G strips. Add 4-1/2" G cornerstones to each end. Add GGG strips to top and bottom of quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Assemble quilt sandwich by placing the backing, batting and top together in layers and baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing. Bind in the usual manner.

FINISHED SIZE: 49" SQUARE
