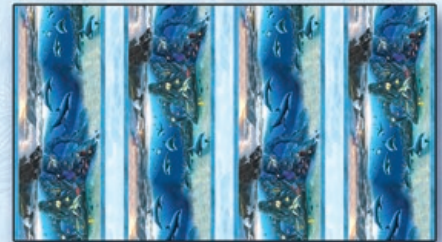

Dance of the Sea Turtles

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - cut individual blocks by centering design evenly: cut 2 - 15 3/4" x 20 1/2" and cut 4 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Fabric B - cut 4 identical border stripes lengthwise 9 3/4" x 60 1/2"

Fabric C - cut 2 - 12 1/2" strips, subcut 4 - 12 1/2" squares

Fabric E - cut 7 - 3 1/4" strips, sew end to end and subcut 4 - 3 1/4" x 60 1/2"

Fabric F - cut 4 - 2" strips, subcut 8 - 2" x 6 1/2" (SIDES) and 8 - 2" x 9 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

cut 1 - 15 3/4" strip, subcut 2 - 13 1/2" x 15 3/4"

BINDING - cut 9 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

Fabric G - cut 2 - 4" strips, subcut 16 - 4" squares, cut squares in half diagonally from both directions ☒

cut 4 - 2" strips, subcut 16 - 2" x 9 1/2"

cut 1 - 5 1/4" strip, subcut 16 - 2 1/2" x 5 1/4"

cut 1 - 1 1/4" strip, subcut 16 - 1 1/4" squares, draw a diagonal line on the backside of all squares ☒

cut 3 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 16 - 1 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Fabric H - cut 3 - 5 3/8" strips, subcut 16 - 5 3/8" squares, cut in half diagonally ☒

cut 3 - 1 3/4" strips, subcut 32 - 1 3/4" x 3 1/4" (legs)

cut 1 - 2 1/2" strip, subcut 8 - 2 1/2" x 3" (head)

cut 1 - 1 1/2" strip, subcut 8 - 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" (tail)

Fabric I - cut 1 - 2" x 36 1/2"

cut 2 - 12 1/2" strips, subcut 4 - 12 1/2" squares

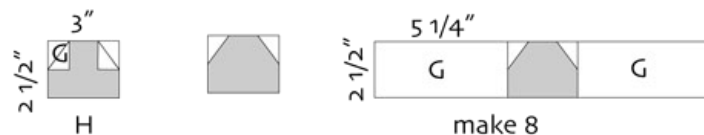
Fabric J - cut 7 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 6 - 1 1/2" x 15 3/4" and 4 - 1 1/2" x 36 1/2"

cut 5 - 2" strips, subcut 8 - 2" x 9 1/2" and

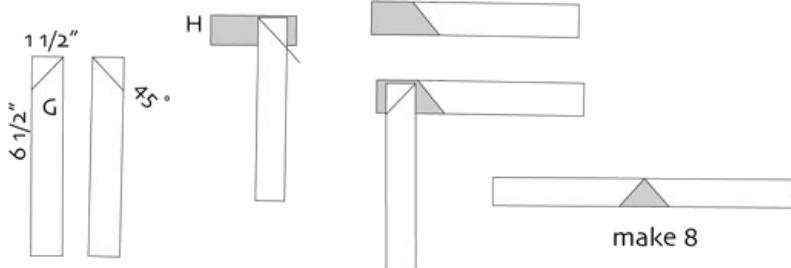
8 - 2" x 12 1/2"

Fabric K - cut 7 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 32 - 1 1/2" x 8"

Head: place one **G** 1 1/4" square over adjacent corners of **H**, right sides together, according to the diagram. Stitch ON the diagonal line, trim 1/4" from seam and press toward triangle. Make 8 head units. Next, sew one **G** 2 1/2" x 5 1/4" strip on each side of head.

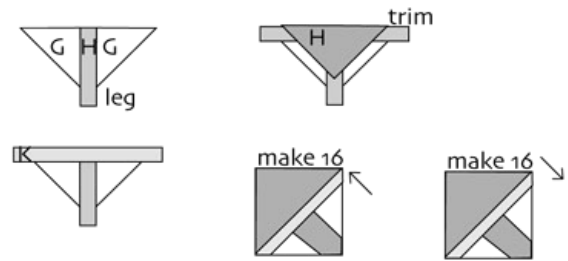


Tail: Draw a 45° line on the backside from one corner of each **G** 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strip (8 to the left and 8 to the right) according to the diagram. Next, match corners of **G** and **H** (tail), right sides together, stitch ON the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from seam and press toward **G**. Next, place the **G** strip with the opposite angle drawn over the opposite corner of **H**. Stitch ON the drawn line, trim and press toward **G**. Make 8 tail rows.

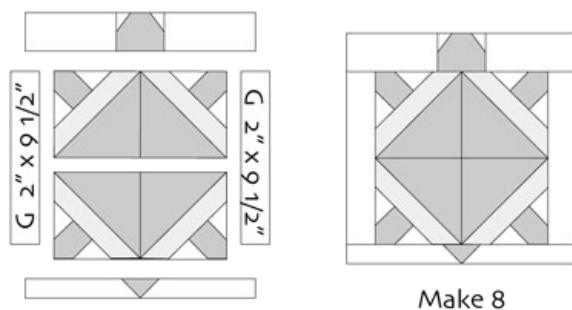


2. Piecing Order:

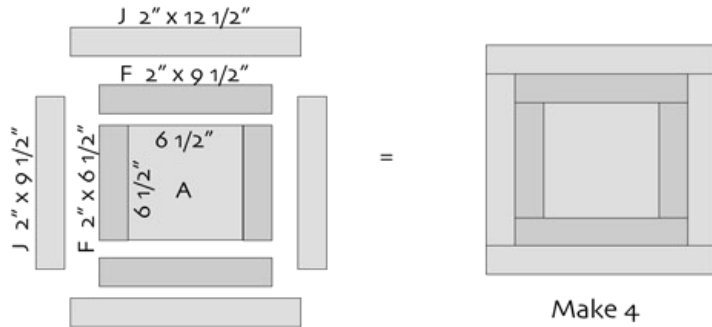
1. Make 8 - 12" finished (12 1/2" unf.) Turtle Blocks. First, sew leg sections by sewing **G** triangles to both sides of **H**, keep top edge straight. Press unit after each piece is added. Next, sew leg section to **K** by centering both. Add **H** large triangles by centering evenly. Once **H** triangle has been sewn, use it as a template and trim both sides of the underneath unit to match **H**. Make 32 units, press half toward **H** triangles and half toward **K** strip.



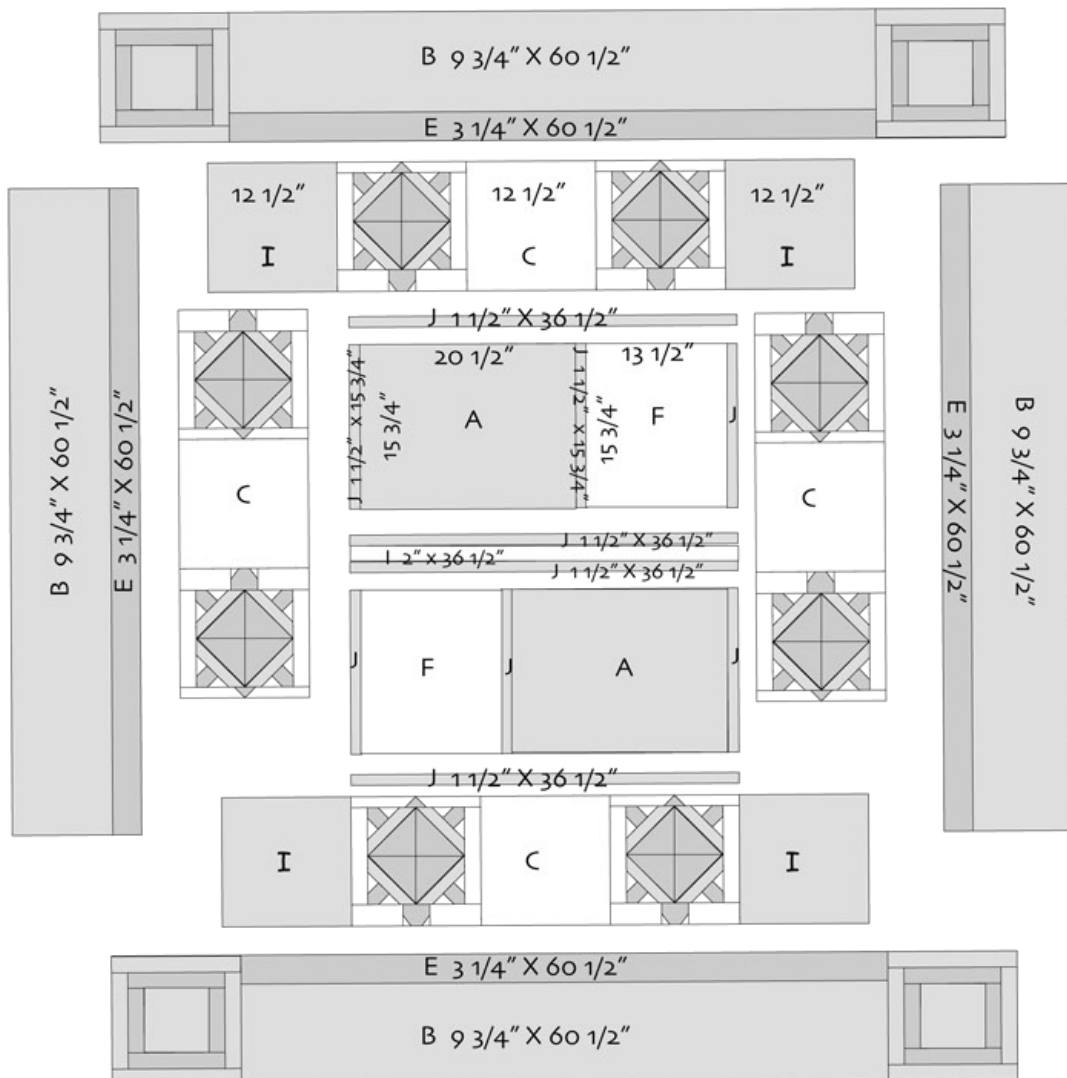
Sew Turtle Blocks together by rows. Sew body/leg units first, then sew **G** 2" x 9 1/2" to both sides. Next sew head row to the top and the tail to the bottom of the block.



2. Make 4 - 12" finished (12 1/2" unfin.) Corner Blocks. Sew **F** borders around each **A** square, **SIDES** first then **TOP** and **BOTTOM**. Next, sew **J** borders, **SIDES** first then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.



3. Sew quilt together by rows, starting with the center blocks (**F** and **A**) according to the diagram.



4. The quilt measures approximately 85" x 85". Make backing (**Fabric D**) at least 6" larger than the top. Baste together backing, batting and top. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**F**). Enjoy!!
