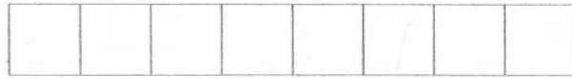
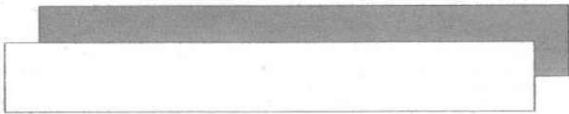


How to Make a Half Square Triangle

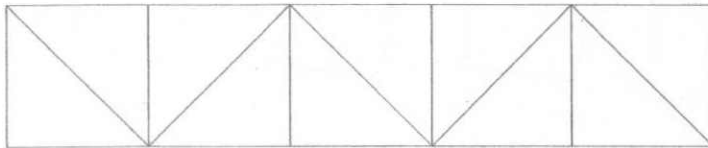
1. Determine the finished size of the half square unit
2. Add One inch to this measurement

Finished size for this project

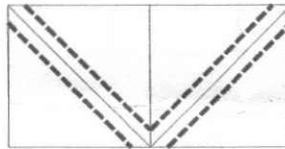
3. Cut strips that are this wide by the Width of Fabric (WOF) from each of two fabrics.
4. Place one strip of each color right sides together resting on a sheet of sandpaper.
5. Measure and draw a pencil line to divide the strip into squares. (i.e. of the strip width = 4 inches, draw a line every 4 inches).



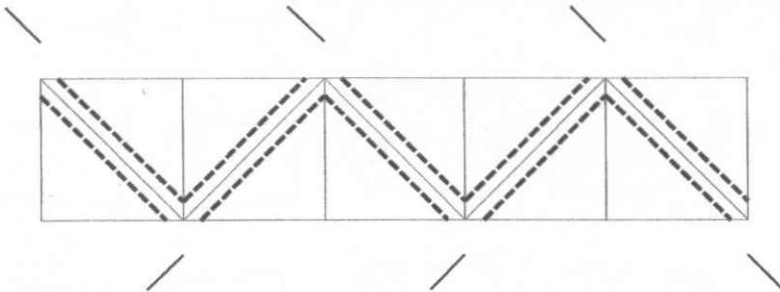
6. Draw solid lines that run on the diagonal to divide the squares into triangles as illustrated.



7. Draw a dashed line 1/4 inch from the original line.

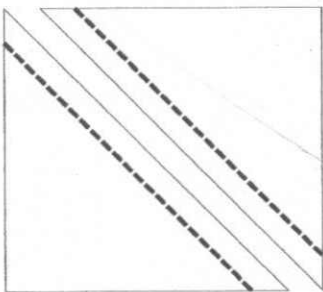


8. Sew along the dashed lines down the row of squares.



9. Turn the fabric and sew the dashed lines in the other direction.

10. Use the rotary cutter and ruler to cut the fabric on the SOLID lines.



11. Press open. Trim so square equals finished size plus 1/2 inch
