


# Boo!

Reverse Templates for Fusible Appliqué.

## Fabric Requirements:

### Purple Version

**Fabric A:** 1/2 yard of 5609 Plum  
**Fabric B:** 5/8 yard of 5611 Pumpkin  
**Fabric C:** 7/8 yard of 5610 Purple  
**Fabric D:** 1/2 yard of 5608 Teal  
**Fabric E:** 1/3 yard of 4387 Berry  
**Fabric F:** 2 yards\* of 5607 Teal  
**Fabric G:** 1/2 yard of 5611 Purple  
**Fabric H:** 3/4 yard of M4875 Alabaster  
**Fabric I:** 3/4 yard of 3504 Papaya  
**Fabric J:** Fat 1/16 of 4387 Artichoke  
**Fabric K:** 1/8 yard of 3955 Jet  
**Backing:** 3-3/4 yards of 5610 Green  
**Fusible Web:** 2 yards

### Royal Version

**Fabric A:** 1/2 yard of 5609 Royal  
**Fabric B:** 5/8 yard of 5611 Pumpkin  
**Fabric C:** 7/8 yard of 5610 Charcoal  
**Fabric D:** 1/2 yard of 5608 Royal  
**Fabric E:** 1/3 yard of 4391 Broccoli  
**Fabric F:** 2 yards\* of 5607 Royal  
**Fabric G:** 1/2 yard of 5611 Royal  
**Fabric H:** 3/4 yard of M4875 Alabaster  
**Fabric I:** 3/4 yard of 3504 Papaya  
**Fabric J:** Fat 1/16 of 4387 Artichoke  
**Fabric K:** 1/8 yard of 3955 Jet  
**Backing:** 3-3/4 yards of 5610 Green  
**Fusible Web:** 2 yards

\*or enough to get seven repeats of the stripe border as shown.

## Cutting Directions:


**Fabric A:** Cut eight 6-1/2" squares.  
**Fabric B:** Cut twenty-six 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips and twenty-six 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips.  
**Fabric C:** Cut twelve 8-1/2" squares.  
**Fabric D:** Fussy cut five 6-1/2" squares centering each on a motif.  
**Fabric E:** Cut six 1-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips.  
Piece the strips together to make two 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips for the Inner Border.  
**Fabric F:** Cut seven repeats from the stripe 7-1/2" wide over the motif as shown in the photo. Match up the printed pattern on the strips to piece together four 7-1/2" x 58-1/2" strips for the Outer Border.

## Assembly Instructions:

1. Sew one 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of one 6-1/2" Fabric A square. Sew one 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the 6-1/2" Fabric A square. Repeat to make eight Fabric A Blocks.
2. Sew one 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of one 6-1/2" Fabric D square. Sew one 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the 6-1/2" Fabric D square. Repeat to make five Fabric D Blocks.
3. Enlarge the templates 200%. Following the manufacturer's instructions trace the listed number templates onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template an 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
4. Refer to the cutting directions and press each template onto the back side of the listed fabrics. Cut out each shape on the drawn line.
5. Refer to the quilt photo and assemble each ghost and each pumpkin on top of one 8-1/2" Fabric C square. Press in place.
6. Finish the raw edges of each appliquéd piece with a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch to complete the six pumpkin blocks and six ghost blocks.
7. Refer to the quilt photo for block placement. Sew the Fabric A blocks, Fabric D blocks, ghost blocks and pumpkin blocks together into five rows with five blocks in each.
8. Sew the five rows together to make the quilt top.
9. Sew one 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
10. Center one 7-1/2" x 58" Fabric F strip on one side of the quilt top. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the quilt top and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.
11. Repeat with the remaining three sides, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the quilt top to sew the three remaining 7-1/2" x 58" Fabric F strips to the quilt top.
12. To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal back sides together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 1).
13. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 1) draw a 45° line out to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

**Fabric G:** Cut six 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.  
**Fabric H:** See instructions to cut six ghosts.  
**Fabric I:** See instructions to cut six pumpkins.  
**Fabric J:** See instructions to cut six stems  
**Fabric K:** See instructions to cut the ghost and pumpkin eyes and noses.  
**Backing:** Sew into one 64" piece for the backing.
