

# Donkey

12" x 25"

Materials: 1 yard for background and binding, 3/4 yard of contrast fabric, 1/4 yard for donkey body, 1/8 yard for scrap of white for eye.

Donkey body is a mosaic of squares and rectangles, which is appliquéd onto a whole-cloth background. Quilting extends the grid over the background.

5: Make templates: a 1 5/8" square and half-rectangle from fabric for donkey body, cut 46 squares and half-squares. From contrast fabric cut 4 squares and half-squares. From white, cut 1 half-square.

OP: Refer to chart and arrange squares and rectangles. Sew half-squares together to form squares if possible. Sew patches into horizontal rows and then rows together.

6: Cut a 27 1/2" x 25" rectangle from both background and backing fabric; do not add seam allowance. Appliqué the donkey mosaic on background; appliqué in

LY AND QUILTING: Mark quilt top: extend lines of mosaic onto background, continuing grid over entire surface. Cut batting and assemble quilt top in the seams and along the marked lines. VG: Using same fabric as background, make a 1/4" binding, and attach.

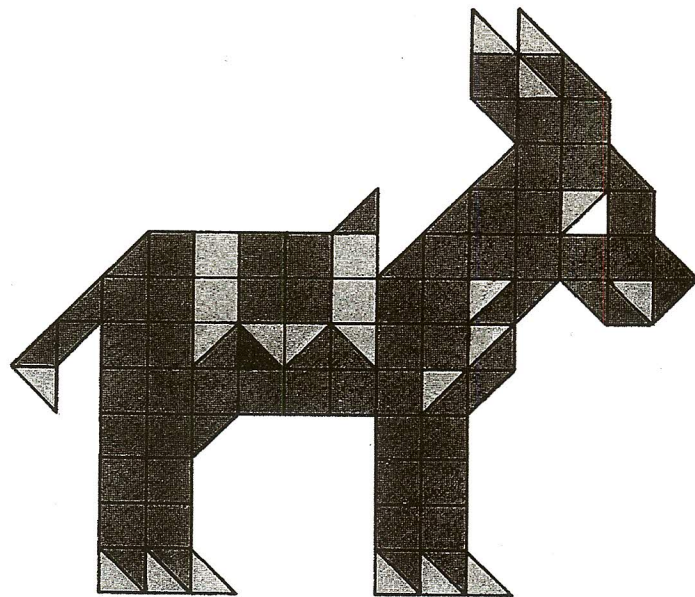
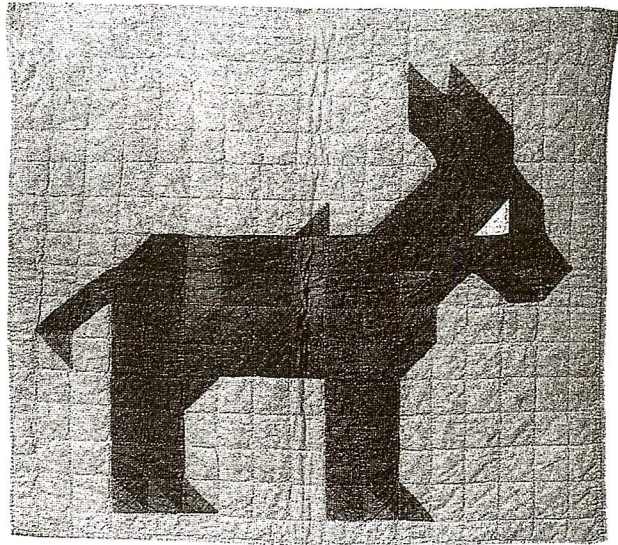


Chart for Donkey
