
Spring Sampler–Celebrating Make a Quilt Day, April 18th

Materials

Choose scraps of the minimum size listed for each fabric or cut from fat quarters.

10" x 16" rectangle white background print (A, B1, and C) 7 1/2" x 9" rectangle of bright pink print (D1, D2, and E) 8" square purple print (D1, D2, and E) Scrap of yellow print (F) 7 " x 11" rectangle of green print #1 (B2, H, I, and J) 3 1/2" x 7" rectangle of green print #2 (G) 4" square of fusible web for leaves H and I 1" x 10" strip of fusible web for stem (J)

Cut the Pieces

Refer to Figure 1 for piece identification.

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
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Make the Block

Use 1/4"-wide seam allowances.


 Cut the left end of each 2" x 3 3/8" rectangle (D1) at a 45-degree angle as shown in Figure 2. Discard the cutaway triangles. Repeat with the remaining rectangles (D2) at the right end as shown for 2 each of the bright pink and 1 each of the purple. Figure 2.








2. Cut away the right and left end of each of the (3) 1 7/8" x 6 7/8" rectangles at a 45-degree angle to create 2 bright pink and 1 purple trapezoid (E)) as shown in Figure 3.




Cut 2 bright pink


 Sew each D1 piece from step 2 to a yellow halfsquare triangle (F). Sew each D2 piece to a 2" square of white background print (C). Press as directed by the arrows. Sew the units together as shown to make 2 bright pink corner units and 1 purple corner unit. Figure 4.



4. Sew each trapezoid (E) from step 2 to a green print #2 triangle (G). Press the seam allowances toward the trapezoids. Figure 5.



5. Sew the corner units from step 3 to a matching-color E/G unit from step 4. Press the seam allowances toward the trapezoids. Make 2 bright pink flower units and 1 purple flower unit. Figure 6.




6. Sew the B1 and B2 half-square triangles together and press the seam allowances toward the green triangle. Figure 7.







 Arrange the flower units and the B1/B2 halfsquare triangle unit with the 4 1/2" squares of white background print (A) in rows as shown in Figure 8. Sew together in rows and press the seam allowances as directed by the arrows. Sew the rows together and press as directed.




TEMPLATE PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS Be sure your printer is set-up to print at 100% –not scaled or reduced to fit.

Note: If you have already printed the template pages, send this page to your printer again. When the "Print" menu screen appears, locate the "Page Scaling" option box. If 100% or None is *not* selected, discard the already-printed template pages. Then select 100% or None, and send the template pages to the printer again to print accurately sized templates.

- Trace the leaves (H and I at right) onto the paper side of the 4" square of fusible web. Apply the fusible web to the wrong side of the 4" square of green print #1. Cut out the leaves on the drawn lines. Apply the 1" x 10" strip of fusible web to the 1" x 10" strip of green print #1 and the. Trim to 3/4" x 9 3/8".
- 9. Referring to Figure 1, position the leaves (H and I) and the stem (J) on the block and fuse in place. Note that the upper end of the stem should overlap the corner of the green triangle G. Add machine blanket stitching around the raw edges of the appliqués to complete the Crazy for Cosmos block.
