## Stash Friendly Placemats - JUNE

Fabric: the number in parenthesis () indicates quantity needed for ONE placemat. Multiply for the quantity you are making. Sizes shown are CUT sizes.

Yellow
(3) $2-3 / 8$ " squares

Red
(1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

Blue
(1) $20-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

Background
(1) $13-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(1) $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(3) $2-3 / 8$ " squares
(2) 2 " $\times 5^{\prime \prime}$
(3) 2 " squares
(1) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

Construction: See the $1 / 4$ " seam allowance information in the General Instructions

1. Place each Yellow $2-3 / 8$ " square right sides together with a $2-3 / 8$ " square of Background. Draw a diagonal line across the Background.
2. Stitch an accurate $1 / 4$ " on each side of the drawn line.

3. Cut each apart. These half square triangles should measure 2" square from raw edge to raw edge.

4. Stitch (5) of the Yellow Triangles plus a 2" square of Background together, as shown.
5. Add a 2" x 5" Background along each side of the Step 4 sails.

6. Diagonally stitch a 2 " square of Background on both ends of the 2 " x 6-1/2" Red. They will be mirror images, as shown. Trim the excess and press toward the corner.

7. Stitch the Sails on top of the Boat.
8. Attach the $1-1 / 2$ " $\times 6-1 / 2$ " Background to the left of the Sailboat, followed by the $7-1 / 2$ " $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background on top of the Sailboat
9. The $13-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background goes to the right of the above unit.
10. Finally, stitch the $20-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Blue across the bottom.
