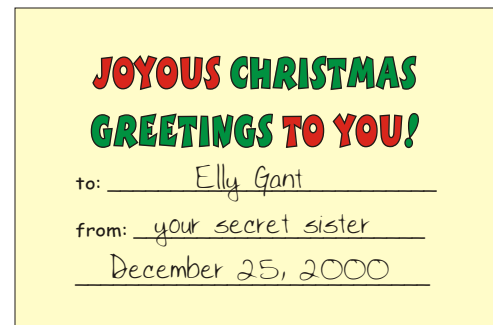

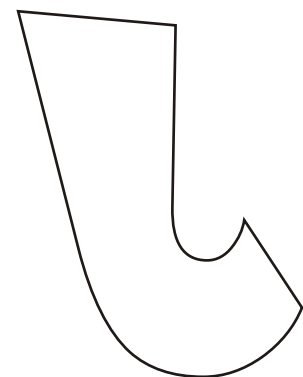
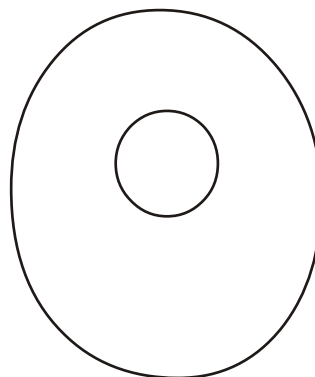
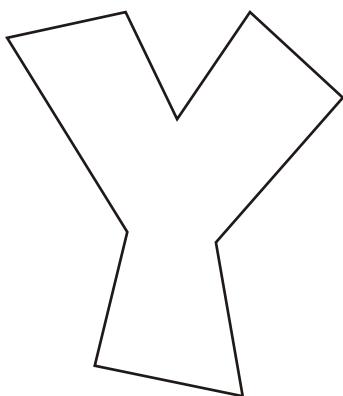
Make this quick and easy little quilt card for someone special this Christmas season!

You will need:

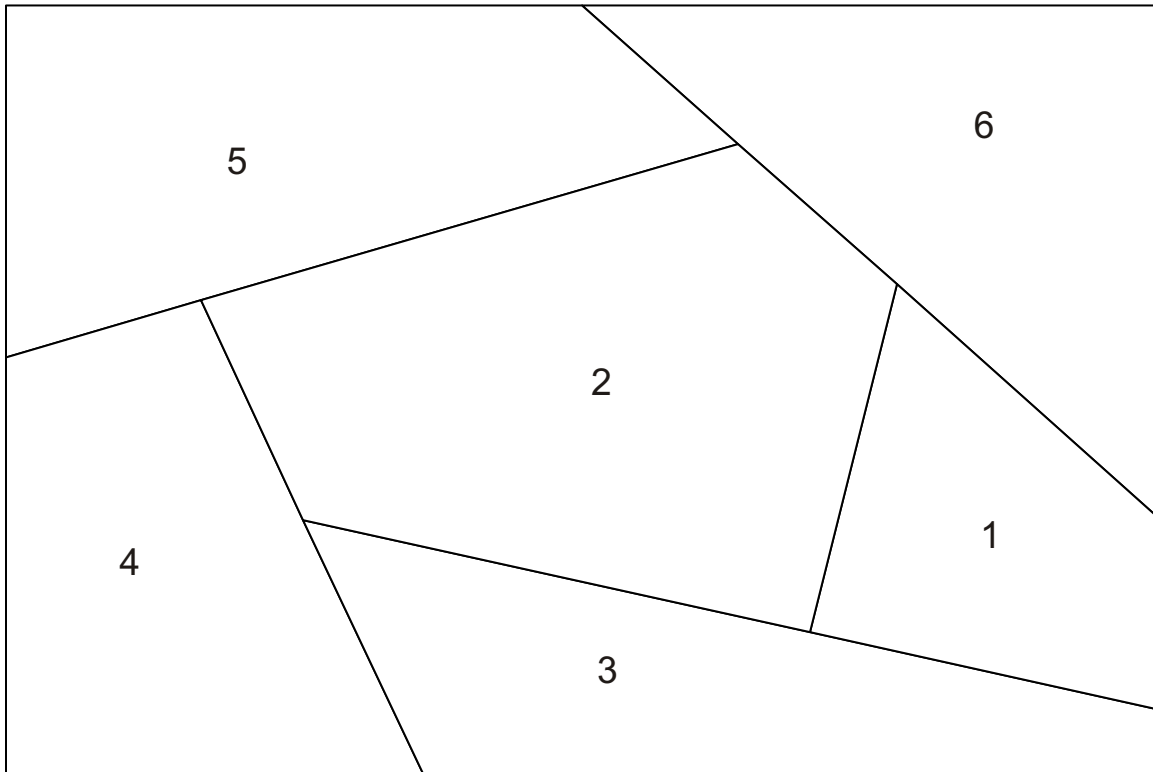
- patterns on page 2
- bright fabric scraps and a small scrap of black
- 4½" x 6½" piece of muslin
- 4½" x 6½" piece of thin batting or flannel
- fusible adhesive (sew through type)
- pigment pens
- basic sewing supplies



1. Using the pattern on page 2, paper piece the crazy quilt background block.
2. Trace the reversed letters onto the paper side of the fusible. Cut out letters about ¼" from outside lines. Following the manufacturer's instructions, fuse to the wrong side of the black fabric scrap. Cut letters out on line and fuse to the finished crazy quilt block. Using hand or machine embroidery, stitch around the raw edges of the letters.
3. Using pigment pens, trace the lettering onto the muslin rectangle. Color as desired and address the quilt card.
4. With right sides together and using a ¼" seam, stitch the front and back of card together leaving an opening for turning. Turn, press and stitch opening closed.
