## HELPFUL HINTS FOR MAKING AWARD WINNING QUILTS

# General Appearance

- Cleanliness
- Quilt hangs flat
- Has visual appeal

## Design

- Elements should be in proportion
- Overall Design effective
- Color should complement the design

### Construction

## - Piecing

Sharp points
Straight seams; smooth curves
Uniform size of blocks
Technique is important

### Appliqué

Sharp points, smooth curves
Small, even stitches
Decorative stitching should support design
Technique is important

# - Setting

In edge-to-edge block setting, blocks should meet exactly Sashing strips should surround all blocks, be straight and appropriate

#### Borders

Compatible to the quilt Enhance design of the quilt

### Binding

Corners meet at 90-degree angle Quilt batting should fill binding Smooth joints Finishing stitches should be almost invisible Binding should complement quilt

### Quilting

- Quilt lies flat, even stitches, no visible knots, no marking visible
- Design complements quilt, adequate amount of quilting
- Balanced amount of quilting throughout quilt and border(s)
