## **PUFF BABY QUILT**

Cut all squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2 "
I use flannel. Be sure to prewash the fabric.
Backing 2 yds.
Batting – Crib size (45" x 63")

3/8 yd.	Color 1	cut 16 squares from 2 strips
1/2 yd.	Color 2	cut 24 squares from 3 strips
5/8 yd.	Color 3	cut 32 squares from 4 strips
3/4 yd.	Color 4	cut 40 squares from 5 strips
7/8 yd.	Color 5	cut 48 squares from 6 strips
1 yd.	Color 6	cut 56 squares from 7 strips

Sewing—Place Color 5 right sides together on top of Color 6. Sew a few stitches and, holding both pieces, form a small pleat in center of square. Sew to the end of the square. Do not cut threads. Just pick up next Color 6-5 and sew as before placing in the pleat each time. Sew to the end of first row. Then carefully slide sewn work from back to the front. Open out the sewn squares and now place Color 4 right sides together with Color 6-5. Again sew to the bottom of the stack and slide as before. When all squares have been sewn in one set, then sew in the crosswise seams. Always put in the pleat. To match up corners of blocks, place one seam one direction and the other seam the opposite direction. Always noting how the seam has been sewn previously.

Sew 4 quarters together making sure the Color 1 looks like this (2 rows of 8). Sew around the outer blocks putting in the pleats. Sandwich the backing, batting and quilt top. Pin at every-other block corner. Bring backing around to the sides and sew to create a binding. Then bring top and bottom of backing to the front and sew to finish the binding. Tie quilt with yarn.
