General instructions for the quilt below:


There are two main blocks in the quilt, as shown below (Block A and Block B):


Blocks are $12^{\prime \prime}$ finished. Center square of each block is 4 " finished, all strips are $2^{\prime \prime}$ finished width.

Blocks are set on point. The center of the quilt above is about $68^{\prime \prime} \times 85$, the inner border is $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ finished, and the outer border is 9 " finished, for a total size of about $91^{\prime \prime} \times 108^{\prime \prime}$.

Corner and side setting triangles are built similar to Block B.

I actually prefer the look of the following quilt, made with corner and side setting triangles from one fabric. These triangles are simpler to make, and I think they make the quilt center appear to float.
