## Burgoyne Surrounded Week Five: The Block

Warning: Background is shown light and design as dark!
Note: Numbers for smaller quilt are given in parenthesis!
Yep... We need still more Background Pieces.
Cut 2(1) $31 / 2$ " background strips. From each strip, cut 1(o) 5 1/2" X 3 1/2" D rectangle and 15 (17) $21 / 2 "$ X 3 1/2" B rectangles.
** Cut 2(1) 3 1/2" background strips. From each strip, cut 15 (17) 2 1/2" X 3 1/2" B rectangles.
*** Cut 10(6) ea. 3 1/2" background strips. Sub-cut 5 ea. 5 1/2" X 3 1/2" D rectangles and 5 ea. 2 1/2" X 3 1/2" B rectangles.

Note: Need a grand total of 80 (48) D units (3 1/2" X $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) and 160 (96) B units ( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{X} 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ )

## At Last... The Block!



Using the 4-Patches, the 9-Patches, the Side Units and Uneven 9-Patches along with those $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{X} 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{B}$ and $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{X} 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ D background rectangles you've cut, put together 20 (12) blocks in a row by row format as illustrated. Watch the orientation of those 4-Patches and the Side units to be sure you have the right pattern.
