Burgoyne Surrounded Week Five: The Block

Warning: Background is shown light and design as dark!


Note: Numbers for smaller quilt are given in parenthesis! Yep... We need still more Background Pieces.

Cut 2(1) 3 1/2" background strips. From each strip, cut 1(0) 5 1/2" X 3 1/2" D rectangle and 15 (17) 2 1/2" X 3 1/2" B rectangles.

- ** Cut 2(1) 3 1/2" background strips. From each strip, cut 15 (17) 2 1/2" X 3 1/2" B rectangles.
- *** Cut 10(6) ea. 3 1/2" background strips. Sub-cut 5 ea. 5 1/2" X 3 1/2" D rectangles and 5 ea. 2 1/2" X 3 1/2" B rectangles.

Note: Need a grand total of 80 (48) D units (3 1/2" X 5 1/2") and 160 (96) B units (2 1/2" X 31/2")

At Last... The Block!



Using the 4-Patches, the 9-Patches, the Side Units and Uneven 9-Patches along with those 2 1/2" X 3 1/2" B and 3 1/2" X 5 1/2" D background rectangles you've cut, put together

20 (12) blocks in a row by row format as illustrated.

Watch the orientation of those 4-Patches and the Side units to be sure you have the right pattern.
