

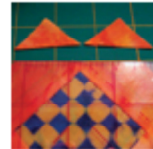
## Pineapple block with honey bun

2. Using a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, sew the top and bottom patches of row 1 to the center square. Press seams away from the center square.

3. Add side patches of Row 1 to center square, and press seams away from center square.



4. trim Row 1 patches. Trim all four sides of Row 1.

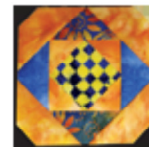


5. Center Row 2 patches right sides together, matching with raw edges of Row 1. Sew top and bottom Row 2 patches to Row 1 and press seams away from center square.

6. Repeat process, and sew side patches of Row 2 to Row 1, pressing seams away from center square.



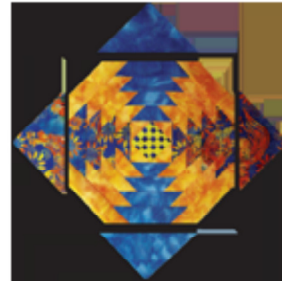
7. trim Row 2 patches.



8. Continue adding odd and even rows of logs by centering patches right sides together in this manner, through Row 9. Always press seams away from center square.



13. Add Row 10 triangle units to the four corners of the block. Press seams away from center square.



14. square up the completed block.
