

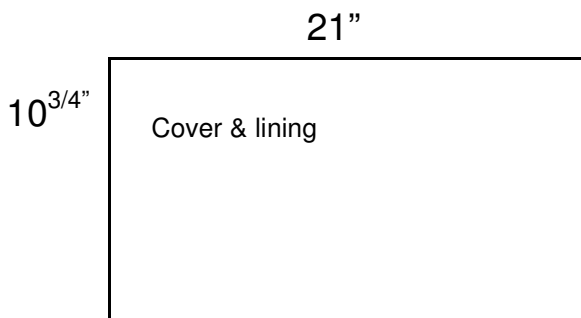
## Fabric Journal Cover Directions

### Supplies

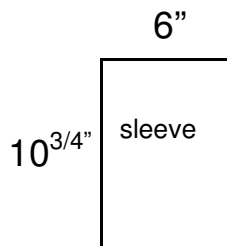
- 2 coordinating fabrics 1/2 yd each (a fat quarter works)
- Heavy weight iron-on interfacing
- Thread
- Colored hair elastics
- Button

### Directions

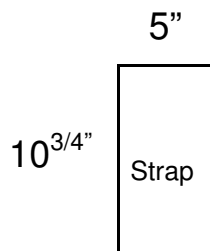
Cut both pieces of fabric  $10^{3/4}$  inches x 21 inches, cut one piece from interfacing also  $10^{3/4}$  inches X 21 inches



Out of remaining fabric cut one piece and a piece of interfacing 6 inches X  $10^{3/4}$  inches



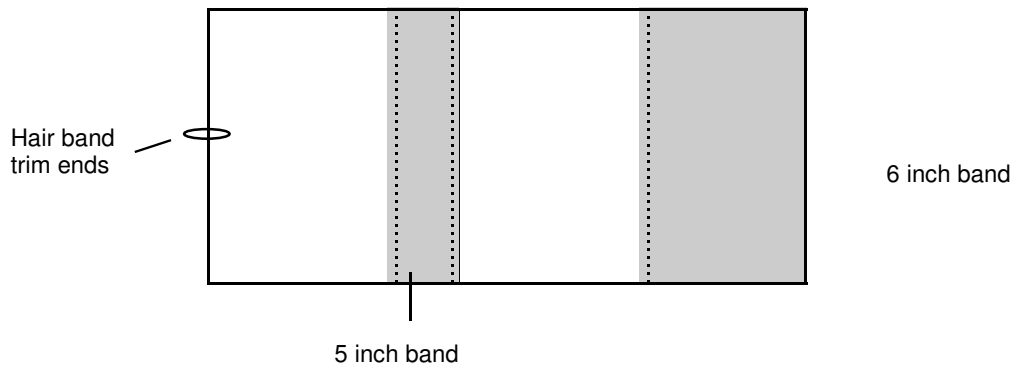
Cut one piece of fabric and a piece of interfacing 5 inches X  $10^{3/4}$  inches



Iron interfacing on corresponding pieces.

Sew a hem of a 1/4" inch on one side of sleeve and hem both sides of the strap also, 1/4 inch.

Stay stitch sleeve and pockets face down on outside of journal cover. Sew a colored elastic hair band on opposite side of the sleeve in middle. Trim off the ends of the elastic hair band. Place strap at 10" on the cover.



Now place lining on top of this and sew around leaving an opening large enough to turn journal cover right side out. Cut corners off, turn right side out. Slip stitch opening shut and sew on button on front of cover. Insert composition notebook and your done.

You can decorate the outer cover prior to making the journal cover. I also put a small pocket on the inside of another.
