
PP 5 Point Star in circle and square 5 point #2


To easily make this block:

- 1. Paper piece the star and the circle
- 2. Piece the 4 patch background.
- 3. Sew the completed PP star and circle, RST, to a piece of light to medium weight sew-in interfacing.
- 4. Sew all the way around the circle, using a 1/4" seam.
- 5. Carefully, cut a 3" slit JUST through the interfacing in the center of the circle.
- 6. Turn the circle right side out through the cut hole in the interfacing.
- 7. Press, making sure that none of the white from the interfacing shows on the around the circle.
- 8. Sew to the 4 patch block with your favorite technique: needleturn, satin stitch, or with a blind stitch, using monofiliment thread (my favorite).




PP 5 Point Star in circle and square 5 point #2
