

Flying Geese – Shortcut Sheet Method

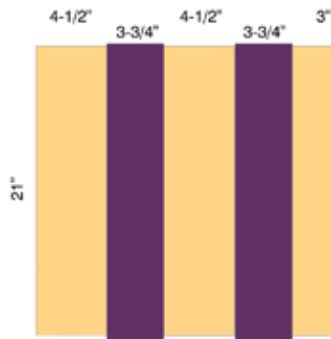
Step 1

To make 20 *Flying Geese* units, use strips of fabric 21" wide (fat quarter width):

- two (2) *Geese body* strips 3-3/4" wide
- two (2) *Sky* strips 4-1/2" wide
- three (3) *Sky* strips 3" wide

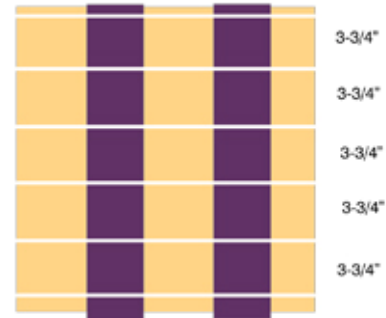


Step 2



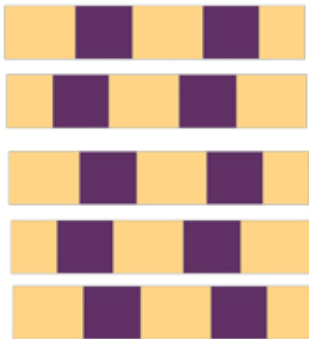
Tighten the stitch length on your machine. Use a 1/4" foot and sew strips together starting with a sky strip. Press seams *open* to avoid curl.

Step 3



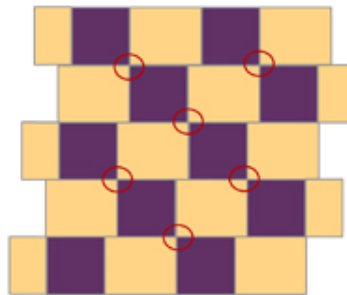
Straighten top edge then cut strips 3-3/4" wide. Use a 24" ruler and line up the seam with a straight line on the ruler.

Step 4



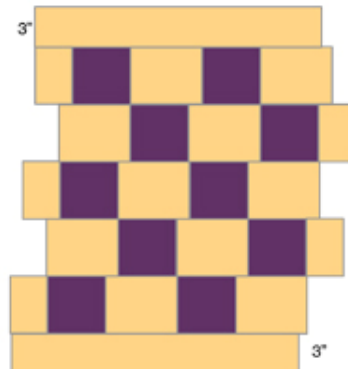
Flip every second strip horizontally.

Step 5



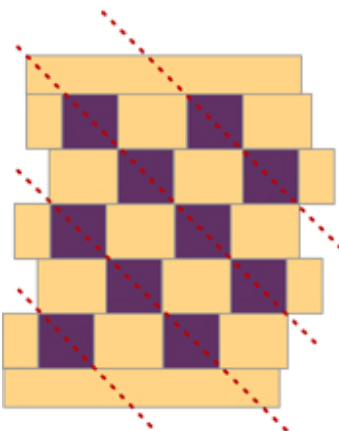
Sew strips together aligning the bottom right of the geese body with the top left of the geese body square below.

Step 6



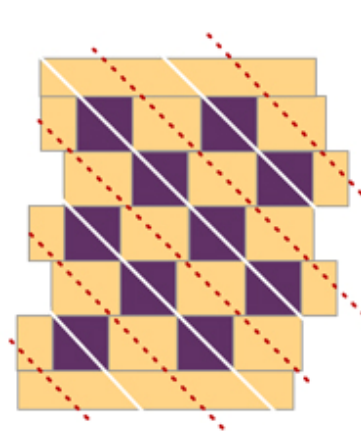
Add 3" strips of sky to the top and bottom.

Step 7



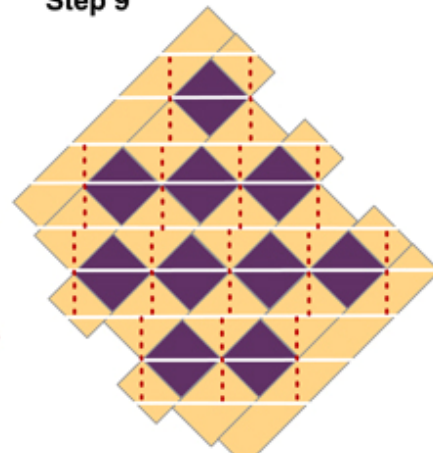
First cut diagonally through squares (geese body)

Step 8



Then cut diagonally between squares (sky)

Step 9



Finally cut the geese apart. Line up the body with a straight line on your ruler to make sure the corners are square.
